BUCHWALTER, Enos* 15 Aug 1862

Private Enos Buchwalter was 21 when he entered service. He died 16 Aug 1863 at Port Hudson, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says he is buried at Port Hudson, Louisiana.

Mother: Anna HARTMAN

Death: 16 Aug 1863, Port Hudson LA

Martin's Cem, Baughman Twp, Wayne co OH. Enos has a stone and flag holder at Martin's Cemetery, Section 2, Baughman Twp, Wayne Co OH. Born 20 Apr 1841. Died 16 Aug 1863. He is beside Jacob BUCHWALTER who died in 1890.

Relationship: Brother of Daniel BUCHWALTER, Co A 120th

Register of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Enos BUCKWALTER, Pvt, Co A 120 OH Inf. Dies 17 Aug 1863 at Regimental Hospital. Cause: Remittant fever. Signed by Byron Stanton.
