CRAMER, Benjamin Not on original list in the Official Roster of the Soldiers of the State of Ohio in the War of the Rebellion.

Private

Died: 10 Mar 1863 on floating hospital "Nashville"

Burial: Could be buried at Vicksburg as an unknown. No evidence.

Is listed as Pvt Benjamin Cramer in Co A 120th OH Inf, at Civil War Soldiers and Sailors System.
