

Company A, 120th OVI

ENGLISH, Samuel A. 6 Oct 1862

1st Lieutenant English was age 24 when he entered service. [His records show that he was, on 23 Dec 1862, made acting Aide de Camp on the Staff of the General Commanding. He was a 2nd Lieut at that time.] He was transferred from Co. K on 17 Apr 1863; [According to records, at Vicksburg, July 25, 1863, Samuel was a 1st Lieut in Co B. He tendered his resignation for reason of disability and pressing business at home. The Major Commander at Vicksburg was W. Slocum. He said of this resignation, "approved and strongly recommended. The applicant is unreliable and indolent and utterly unworthy the position he holds and I hope that his resignation will be accepted at once for the benefit of the service.]; resignation accepted 30 July 1863, resigned 1 Aug 1863. [According to papers in the widow's pension, Samuel A. English became a 2nd Lieutenant in the 124th Regt U.S. Colored Infantry at Louisville KY, he having received a commission dated 20 Dec 1864 and mustered 19 Jan 1865. He was cashiered out 9 Sept 1865.]

Samuel is in Section J-Division 2-Lot 80-Loc.C There is no tombstone for Samuel. Daughter Grace is in J-2-80-R Grace died of diphtheria. So the stone in Wooster, next to her mother's grave, is just a memorial stone for Grace and for another girl named Mary Love English, who may be another daughter.

Pension Index: Samuel A ENGLISH, A and K 120th OH and also unas'd [unassigned] 24 USC Inf. Widow Rebecca L ENGLISH filed 1890 Sept 13, Application 462659, filed in PA. But she never received certificate number.

"Camp Keigwin, Miss

July 9th, 1863

To M. M. Spiegel

Col. Comdy 120th Regt OH

In consequences of an ailing in my head consisting of deafness caused by the explosion of a shell at "Chickasaw Bayou" in Dec 1862 & subsequent exposure in the different marches etc which renders me entirely unfit for the service & incapable of properly filling the position I occupy as an officer in the service of the united states as well as other causes towit pressing Business which calls for my immediate presence at home. I hereby tender my unconditional resignation as 1st Lieut in the 120th regiment of Ohio Infantry vols. I am not in any way indebted to the US Govt . Have never been absent from my regiment without proper authority. Was last paid by Major Mayborne up to April 30th 1863.

1860 Census, Millersburg, Hardy Twp, Holmes County, OH, page 324: S. ENGLISH, age 25 PA, no occupation. He was living at the Inn of Joseph WILSON.

Future wife: 1860 Census, Wooster Twp, Wayne County OH, page 146: Reb FLOOD, age 18 [female] OH, was living with Jon [age 41 OH, farmer] and Mary [age 40 VA] STIBBS.

Wayne County Probate Court record: Samuel A ENGLISH married Rebecca L FLOOD on 14 Feb 1861 in Wayne County OH. Married in Wooster [widow's pension]

Was Mary Love ENGLISH also their daughter? Probably. Where did she die? The tombstone in Wooster Cemetery says she died 23 Oct 1867.

Have not found in 1870.....searched 2 May 2014

They were in Philadelphia by October 1875 when daughter Grace died.

Daughter, Grace W ENGLISH died 20 Oct 1875 at Philadelphia PA, age 9. Buried in Greenwood Cemetery Vault for 20 by Lot. Father S. A. ENGLISH. Mother Rebecca ENGLISH. But has her name on a stone in Wooster OH Cemetery. This stone is in Section 4 next to the stone for Rebecca ENGLISH. [Actual death record says died 18 Oct 1875 of diphtheria. Street 707 Callowhill St. Born Rochester PA [Beaver county]. Burial 10 Oct at Greenwood Vault.

1880 Census, 13th Ward Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, PA, page 221: Head of household Marta TYSON, age 57 NJ, parents born NJ, property owner; tenants included Rebecca ENGLISH, niece, age 39 OH, father born LA, mother born VA, working as housekeeper, listed as married; also listed further down was Margaret ENGLISH, age 15 IA, single, boarder, father born PA, mother born OH.

Letter about the death of Samuel English for his pension:

"State of Pennsylvania

City and County of Philadelphia S. S.

On this 8th day of Sept. A. D. 1890, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public...in and for said County, William M. Augney [or Angney], physician in charge of the Protestant Episcopal City Mission, No 411 Spence ST., Philadelphia, Pa., who being duly affirmed, says: - That Samuel A. English was admitted to the House of Mercy March 28th 1888, suffering from Phthisis, and died there May 29, 1888. That said Phthisis was not due to his own vicious habits; and further, that affiant has no interest direct or indirect in the prosecution of this claim.

[The [Protestant Episcopal City Mission](#) still exists today in Philadelphia. In 1886 the Home for Consumptives opened.]

Rebecca's address in Sep 1890 when she applied for pension was 1257 North 23d St, Philadelphia, PA. [Widow's pension]

Philadelphia City Directory, 1890, page 574: Rebecca L. ENGLISH, widow of Samuel, living at 420 Marshall.

1900 Census, 20th Ward Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, PA, page 56: Rebecca ENGLISH, age 59 OH, born July 1841, widow but marriage is listed as 27 yrs, 5 or 3 children/1 still living, profession listed as boarding house, father born LA, mother born VA.

1910 Census, Ward 20 Philadelphia, Philadelphia Co PA, 1428 Thirteenth St, Dwelling 143, Family 152: Harry DARE, age 63 PA, first marriage, married 33 yrs, parents born PA, manages auction company; Clara M, wife, age 55 PA, first marriage, married 33 yrs, 0 children; Rebecca ENGLISH, boarder, age 69 OH, single, father born LA, mother born VA; Reed H. PALMER, nephew, age 31 PA, single, parents born PA, salesman art? goods; Samuel PALMER, nephew, age 27 PA, single, parents born PA, salesman art? goods.

Rebecca died 24 Jan 1915.

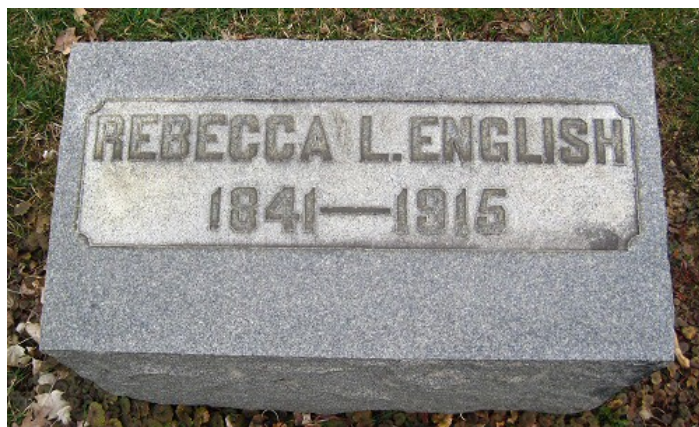
