Private Hileman was age 30 when he entered service.  
He was transferred to Co. H, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865.  
Mustered out 14 Sep 1865.

ISRAEL HILEMAN PASSES TO REST

Israel Hileman, who spent a number of years on a farm near Springville [*this is in Plain township on State*

route 3], west of Wooster, and who sold his farm and moved to Ashtabula county about 25 years ago, died a few days ago. An Ashtabula paper says:

The funeral of Comrade Israel Hileman was held Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Hileman residence on Leslie St. Many friends attended. Twenty-eight G.A.R. men, members of Boyers Post, were present, who also went to the grave in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery.

Rev. C. D. Marston conducted the rite. Rev. C.E. Shaw, rector of Christ Episcopal church, offered prayer at the grave.

Mrs. Hattie Means sang "Asleep in Jesus" and " 'Twill Not Be Long."

The pall bearers were relatives: son, Cleve Hileman from Chicago and A. Hileman; a son-in-law, W.W. Ellis of Ashtabula and three grandsons, Fred and Harry Hileman and Claude Woodworth. Sons, grandsons, and son-in-law, preceded the bier.

Among the out-of-town relatives there were Mrs. Cora Lebo and son, Herbert, of Shreve, O.; a cousin, Henry Winterstein, Wooster, Ohio; J.J. Michel of Bellevue; Mr. and Mrs. Herman Belding of Peru, Ind., who are visiting in Geneva; A. Belding, wife and son and Mrs. L. Suyder [hard to read] of Conneaut.

Interment was made in the family lot beside the remains of his wife, who passed away six years ago.

The deceased was a member of both Masonic lodges, had been a Granger for many years and last years served as Bowers Post commander. He was a soldier for three years in the Civil War.
