

## Company A, 120<sup>th</sup> OVI

LEHMAN, Jacob 16 Aug 1862

Sergeant Lehman was age 29 when he entered service. He was appointed from Corporal on 17 Apr 1863; captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; transferred to Company D 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864.

Pension Card: Jacob LEHMAN of Co A 120th and Co D 114th. Applied for invalid pension 25 Feb 1882, Application 441290, Certificate 376516, filed in MO. Died 27 Mar 1914[incorrect] at Wooster, OH.

1850 Census, Wayne Twp, Wayne County OH, page 282: David LEHMAN, age 48 PA, farmer; Susanna, age 40 PA; Jacob, age 18 OH; Christina, age 16 OH; Elizabeth, age 14 OH; David, age 12 OH; Henry, age 11 OH; Harriet, age 9 OH; Daniel, age 6 OH; Mary, age 3 OH; Simon, age 1 OH. [A record at Family Search shows David LEHMAN married Susan KINTNER on 8 Jan 1829 in Wayne County OH.]

1860 Census, Wayne Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 578, Family 625: David LEHMAN, age 57 PA, farmer; Susan, age 50 PA; Harriet, age 18 OH; Henry, age 21 OH, farm hand; Daniel, age 16 OH; Simon, age 12 OH; Mary, age 14 OH. [Note: I am not sure where Jacob was in 1860. He would have been about 28 yrs old.]

Wayne County Probate Court record: Jacob LEHMAN married Martha WILSON on 28 Feb 1867 in Wayne County, OH.

1870 Census, Wayne Twp, Wayne County OH, page 363: Jacob LEHMAN, age 37 OH, grocery and notions; Martha, age 26 OH; Emma, age 2 OH; Wilson, age 1 OH.

1880 census: Kingston, Caldwell County, Missouri, page 356: Jacob LEHMAN, age 47 OH, farming, parents born PA; Martha A, wife, age 30 OH, father born MD, mother born OH; Emma, daughter, age 12 OH; William W, son, age 10 OH; John W, son age 9 OH; Annie L, daughter, age 5 OH; Jacob B, son, age 4 OH.

Wife, Martha, died in MO in 1883, burial Brame Cemetery, Van Buren, Carter Co MO. [Find a Grave](#)

Did not find on 1890 Veterans Schedule.

??1900 Census Carter Twp, Carter County MO, page 145: Jacob LEHMAN ae 65? OH, born Jan 1836, widowed, a farmer, parents born PA. He is a boarder in the home of Geo H WELLS and family.

1910 Census, Wayne Twp, Wayne County OH, page 37: Jacob LEHMAN, age 78 OH, no occupation, parents born Pa. He is living with his brother-in-law John S EBERLY and John's wife Mary J who is age 63 OH. [see Mary in 1850 census above]

Wooster Daily Republican, Tuesday 27 Mar 1917 [note: the age in this obit seems to be incorrect. Jacob would have been more in the age range of 85. See death record below.]

JACOB LEHMAN DIES TUESDAY -- One of County's Most aged Men Passes Away in Wooster Hospital

Jacob Lehman, aged 95 years, died at 7 o'clock Tuesday morning in Wooster hospital, where he had been taken a week ago for treatment. He underwent an operation on Saturday.

Jacob Lehman was born at Madisonburg December 28th 1831, and was one of the oldest citizens of Wayne county. For a period of nearly 25 years he resided in the ?? Missouri returning to Wayne county about seven years ago.

He is survived by four children: W.W. Lehman, of Pittsburg. J.S. Lehman, of Van Buren, Mo.; C.W. Lehman of San Francisco, an enlisted man in the United States navy, and Miss Emma Lehman, of Madisonburg.

Mr. Lehman was a veteran of the Civil war.

Funeral services will take place from Madisonburg Thursday.

Jacob Lehman was buried in Lehman Cemetery [Salem Lutheran Cem] in Wayne Co Ohio. 1831 to 1917
