SCHAAF, Michael\* 13 Aug 1862

Private Michael Schaaf was age 23 when he entered service. He died 25 Jan 1863. The Roll of Honor says he is buried at St. Louis, Missouri in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery in section 65, grave 8.

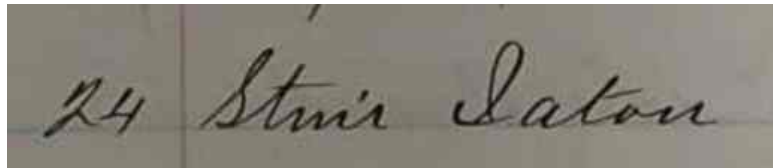

Cemetery: Jefferson Barracks Cemetery, St. Louis Co MO. Michael SHAFF listed at Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery who died 24 June 1863, Civil War, US Army. Section 65, site 10298. Death date not the same as in the Ohio Roster books.

Relationship: Brother of Albert SCHAAF of Co A 120th OVI.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Michael SHEFF, Pvt Co A 120th OH Vols. Died 24 Jan 1863 on the Steamer "Iaton"  
Cause: chronic diarrhoea

1860 Census, Franklin Twp, Wayne Co OH: Michael SHAU, age 61; Elizabeth, age 49; Adam, age 26; George, age 25; Michael, age 21; Edward, age 19; Albert, age 17; John, age 12; William, age 6; Lucretia MOORE, age 16. [Note: This record is not readable, but the family is listed at ancestry.com this way with the spelling SHAUM. ]

Brother's death record: Wm. A. SCHAAF, died 2 Jul 1931 at Franklin, Wayne Co OH. born 13 Sep 1853 in OH. Married, farmer. Burial at Moreland. Spouse Alice. Father Michael SCHAAF, born Germany. Mother Elizabeth STAMAN, born PA.
