SMEDLEY, Samuel 18 Aug 1862  
Private Smedley was age 21 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 8 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Mary, wife, age 76 PA, born Mar 1824, father born Switzerland, mother born Germany, married 44 yrs, 5 children/2 still living; Samuel SMEDLEY, son-in-law, age 59 OH, born Mar 1841, married 31 yrs, parents born PA, an aptitroir???(must be optician..see 1910 census); Kate, daughter, age 57 IL, born Mar 1848, father born PA, mother born OH, married 31 yrs, 2 children/1 still living.

SAMUEL SMEDLEY DIES IN THE WEST

Samuel Smedley, uncle of Charles Lautenschlager of this city, died a few days ago in San Jose, Cal., according to word received today by Mr. Lautenschlager. The deceased was a son of the late John Smedley and after serving in the Civil war lived in Iowa and Kansas. A few years ago he went to San Jose to live a retired life.

The deceased is survived by his wife, a daughter, one brother, William Smedley, and two sisters, Mrs. Jane Blosser of near Applecreek and Mrs. Orrville Kindig of Malletcreek, O. [*Mallet Creek is in Medina county OH.*] [*Orville D. Steele Kindig married Nancy Ellen Smedley who was born in 1854 in Litchfield Twp., Medina Co., OH*] [*Charles Lautenschlager's mother was Julia Anna Smedley.*]

San Jose Mercury News, 12 Nov 1922, page 7:

"Samuel N. Smedley, Civil War Veteran, Dead. Samuel N. Smedley, aged 82, died very suddenly at his home, 94[?] Hollywood avenue yesterday morning. Mr. Smedley had not been in the best of health for several weeks but his condition was not considered serious. Mr. Smedley was a civil war veteran, having enlisted at the age of 21 years in Co A 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio of which state he was a native. He was confined in a rebel prison 14 months and at the time of his death was a member of Bennett Post G A R this city. He leaves a widow and one daughter and a number of relatives and friends to mourn his departure. Funeral services Monday, November 13 at 10:30 a.m. In the funeral parlors of Curry & Grippen ????. Interment in the afternoon in Masonic cemetery San Francisco."
