TOMS, Abraham* 13 Aug 1862

Private Toms was age 28 when he entered service. He died 28 June 1863 at Van Buren Hospital, Milliken's Bend, Louisiana.

The Roll of Honor says he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi section B, grave 103.

Parents: Samuel TOMS married Mary METCALF 10 Dec 1829 in Wayne County OH. And according to a tree at Ancestry, they had a son Abraham born 1833 in Wayne Co OH. They also had Hannah, 1832 and Susanna, 1830. Ohio Obituary Index: Samuel TOM died 24 June 1833 in Wayne Co OH. Samuel TOM had a brother David, husband of Mary McQUILLING. He died in Fulton Co OH.

1860 Census, Plain Twp, Wayne County OH, page 277: Abraham TOMS, age 26 OH?, laborer, is living with Daniel and Adaline FREEMAN and family. [Note: The rest of the family may have been in Fulton Co OH.]
