WALLACE, William W. 29 Aug 1862

Private Wallace was age 23 when he entered service. He was discharged 31 July 1863 on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

"William W. Wallace, son of Robert Wallace, deacon, was professor in Ohio Central College, Iberia, Ohio professor of mathematics in the University of Wooster, and in Westminster College at New Wilmington, Pa. He was a gallant soldier in the Civil War."

1900 Census, Plain Twp, Wayne Co OH: Benjamin WALLACE, age 57 PA, born Jan 1843, married 27 yrs, farmer, father born Ireland, mother born PA: Caroline, wife, age 47 OH, born June 1852, married 27 yrs, no children, parents born OH; Floyd, age 14 OH, adopted son, born May 1886; William W. WALLACE, brother, age 61 OH, single, born Apr 1839, farmer, father born Ireland, mother born OH.

Grave registration card: William W. WALLACE of Co A 120th OVI died in Wayne Co OH, but no date is given. He is buried at Wooster Cemetery, Wooster OH.
