WEAVER, Daniel\* 23 Aug 1862  
Private Weaver was age 23 when he entered service. He died 21 Jan 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana.

Death: 1 Feb 1863 or 21 Jan 1863, Young's Point, LA  
Cemetery: Vicksburg MS [Daniel Weaver not listed there]; Flag holder at Martin Cemetery, Baughman Twp, Wayne Co OH.

The Roll of Honor says he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi. But he is not listed there. There is a flag marker for Daniel at Martin Cemetery, Baughman Twp, Wayne Co OH. It is next to a stone that I could only read as Barbara and Mother in Section 2. There is no separate stone for Daniel.

Sons of Union Veterans says: Daniel WEAVER. Born 9 Mar 1839.

Died 29 Jan 1863.

US Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861 - 1865: Daniel WEAVER, Co A 120th OH inf, died 1 Feb 1863, Regimental Hospital, Typo Mal Fever [Notice the death date]

1850 Census, Baughman Twp, Wayne County Oh, page 168: Eliz. WEAVER, age 43 PA; John, age 22 PA, farmer; Maria, age 24 PA; Marg, age 20 OH; Sarah, age 18 OH; Henry, age 16 OH; Wm, age 14 OH; Danl, age 12 OH.

1860 Census Baughman Twp, Wayne County OH, page 404: Elisabeth WEAVER, age 56 PA; Henry, age 26 OH, farming; William, age 23 OH, farming; Daniel, age 21 OH, farming; A 12 yr old girl is also living there with a different last name and it is too difficult to read.

Possible Brother of Daniel

??Brother's Death record in Ohio: File # 35126, Henry WEAVER died 20 May 1916 at Sugar Creek Twp, Wayne Co OH. He was born 29 May 1834 in OH. He was a farmer. His parents were Daniel WEAVER and Elizabeth KEYES, born PA. Burial Dalton OH. Informant was William D. WEAVER, of Dalton OH.
