ANDREWS, David\* 10 Aug 1862

Sergeant Andrews, was 29 when he entered service. He died 3 May 1863 near Vicksburg, Mississippi. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: David Andrews is buried in section E, grave 163 at Vicksburg, Miss.

Father: James ANDREWS

Mother: Levina CARRICK

Birth: 18 June 1833 Monroe Twp Richland Co OH

Marriage: Single

Death: 3 May 1863, near Vicksburg, MS

Cemetery: Vicksburg, MS Buried as David "ANDERSON" at Vicksburg National Cemetery, section E 1615.

Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960: Moved from grave yard at Marshal Plantation, Madison Parish, LA. running number 580. David ANDREWS, Sergt, Co B 120th OH Inf, died 3 May 1863. Vicksburg [old numbering]section E 163.

National Cemetery Interment Control Form:

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Daniel ANDREWS, Private, Co B 120th OH Inf, died 3 May 1863 at Van Buren General Hospital, Milliken's Bend La. Cause: chronic diarrhoea.

Pension Card: David ANDREWS, Co B 120th OH Inf. Mother, Lavinia, applied for pension 29 Aug 1863, Application 31475. No Certificate.

A Centennial Biographical History of Richland Co OH, by A. J. Baughman, 1901, pp. 557 - 558:

"James and Lovina (Carrick) Andrews had children as follows, mentioned in the order of their nativity: John G., who lives at Freeport, Michigan; James, who died in 1898; William, who died in 1892; Mary J., who lives at Beaver Dam, Indiana; David, a sergeant in the one Hundred and Twentieth Regiment, Ohio Volunteer Infantry, in the war of the Rebellion, who died at Vicksburg; Joseph, who served in the Civil war in the Sixty-fourth Regiment, Ohio Volunteer Infantry, and now lives at Atchison, Kansas; and Samuel." Samuel, Sixth Ohio Battery for three years.

There is an online bio [History of Richland County, Its Past and Present by A A Graham, page 830] of David ANDREW's family at the address below taken from the History of Richland County, Ohio. It states that David was the son of James and Levina [CARSICK] ANDREWS. He was born 18 June 1833 in Monroe Township, Richland County OH. His siblings were: John, James, William, Mary Jane, Joseph and Samuel. David was not married.

1860 Census, Monroe Twp, Richland Co OH, Jane ANDREWS, age 68 PA, manages farm; David, age 25 OH, teaches common school; Joseph, age 22 OH, farmer; Samuel, age 19 OH, farmer.
