AREHART, Columbus 6 Aug 1862 Christopher Columbus AREHART  
Corporal Arehart was 19 when he entered the service. He was appointed Corporal 1 Feb 1864; transferred to Co E 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co E, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

A Centennial Biographical History of Richland Co OH, by A. J. Baughman, 1901, pp 512 - 514:

Christopher C AREHART, born near Perrysville, Ashland Co OH, 29 Apr 1843. Enlisted at age 18. "For a time he was stationed at Covington, Kentucky, and his first engagement was at Chickasaw Bayou, Arkansas Post, Arkansas, January 11, 1863. He also saw service at Thompson's Hill, Mississippi, May 1, 1863; at the siege of Vicksburg, May 18 to July 4, 1863; was appointed corporal May 1, 1864, and fought at Frankfort City, May 3, 1864. Arriving at Snaggy Point, on the Red river, on the transport City Belle, May 3, 1864, the regiment was captured, with the exception of one hundred. After the engagement last mentioned his company became Company E, One Hundred and Fourteenth Regiment, Ohio Volunteer Infantry, Captain Henry Eberhart commanding, and Mr. Arehart took part in the fighting at Graham's plantation, May 5 to May 7, 1864; at Prairie Bayou, May 14 to 16; at De Glaise, May 16, 1864; in the siege of Mobile, March 26 to April 8, 1865; and in the warfare at Fort Blakely, April 2 to 9, 1865. July 24 following he was transferred to Company E, Forty-eighth Regiment, Ohio Volunteer Infantry, and was discharged from the service at Houston, Texas, October 4, 1865, and returned to Ashland county, Ohio and was during one term a student

at the school at Perrysville. After that he devoted himself for a time to learning the plasterer's trade, at which he worked for the next seven years, when he engaged in farming in Monroe township, Richland county."

Married Miss Emma YATES, 2 Jan 1870. Swigart Post, No 116, GAR. Four children: Lloyd, May, John, and Don.

1860 Census Green Township, Ashland County OH: John AREHART, age 42 PA, a farmer; Eliza, age 39 PA; Sarah, age 21 OH; Columbus, age 17 OH; Susan, age 12 OH; Martha J, age 8 OH; Ursala, age 6 OH; John W, age 4 OH.

Richland County Probate Court record: Columbus AREHART married Emiline GATES on 2 Jan 1870 in Richland County OH.

1870 Census Green Township, Ashland County OH: Columbus AREHART, age 27 OH, a plasterer; Sarah E, age 20 OH. They were just married that year according to the census.

1900 Census Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Columbus AREHART, born Apr 1843 OH, age 57, married 30 yrs, a farmer, parents born PA; Sarah E, wife, born Dec 1849 OH, age 50, married 30 yrs, 5 children, 4 living, parents born OH; John, son, born Sep 1878, age 21 OH, single, a farmer; Don, son, born Mar 1888 OH, age 12.

1910 Census Monroe, Township, Richland County OH: Columbus AREHART, age 65 OH, marriage 1, married 40 yrs, no occupation, parents born PA; Sarah, wife, age 60 OH, marriage 1, married 40 yrs, 5 children, 3 still living, parents born OH.

1920 Census, Lucas, Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Columbus AREHART, age 76 OH, no occupation, parents born PA; Sarah, wife, age 70 OH, parents born OH.

1930 Census, Main St., Village (of) Lucas, Monroe Twp., Richland Co., OH, ED 70-30, sheet 3-B, dwelling 73, family 75: N.C. IRWIN, age 56 OH, laborer, furniture store; May, wife, age 54 OH; C.C. AREHART, boarder, age 87 OH, widow, age 27 at first marriage, no occupation listed, father born PA, mother born US, veteran Civ. War. [May AREHART married N.C. IRVIN 26 Mar 1895. Death Record in Ohio: Christopher Columbus AREHART, born 29 Apr 1843 in OH. He was widowed. Spouse Sarah Yates AREHART. [Her death record says her father was Joseph YATORS] Father John AREHART born Germany. Mother Elizabeth SENTLE. Buried in St. John's Cemetery.

Daughter's Death record in Ohio. File #13148 (1941). May IRVIN, widow of Norman C. IRVIN, was born 17 Sep 1875 at Richland Co., OH, and died 28 Feb 1941 at Lucas, OH. Her father, Columbus AREHART, and her mother, Emma YATES, were both born at Richland Co., OH. Burial at Mansfield Cemetery. Informant, Mrs. Walter Swigart, Lucas, OH. [Alverda AREHART SWIGART, wife of Walter SWIGART and daughter of Lloyd AREHART, was May's niece. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Son's Death record in Ohio. File #19377 (1942). Lloyd AREHART, a resident of Lucas, died 12 Mar 1942 at Mansfield, OH. He was born 21 Aug 1871 at Ashland Co., OH. Husband of Burnetta AREHART. His father, Columbus AREHART, and his mother, Sarah YATES, were both born in Ohio. Burial at Mansfield Cemetery. Informant, George AREHART, Lucas, OH. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]
