CULLER, Henry H. 9 Aug 1862

Private Henry Culler was 21 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 19 June 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Father: Michael Long CULLER

Mother: Mary Ann ERNSBERGER

Birth: 23 May 1841, Monroe Twp, Richland Co OH

Marriage: Mary E. HASSINGER [HOSSINGER]

Death: 24 May 1928, Richland Village, Kalamazoo, MI

Cemetery: Prairie Home Cemetery, Richland, Kalamazoo County, MI

Relationship: brother-in-law of Henry D. HASSINGER, also of Co B 120th OVI; cousin of John and Melanthon CULLER, Co B, 120th OVI.

Application for Headstone, War Department, for Henry H. Culler, Pvt. Co B 120th OVI, died 24 May 1928, burial at Prairie Home Cemetery, Richland, MI. Shipped to Bruce Culler, Richland MI, Kalamazoo County. Dated 6 June 1928 and signed by Bruce Culler. Shipped 18 Dec 1928.

Pension Index: Henry H CULLER, B 120th and D 114th OH Inf. Invalid filed 1879 Nov 3, Application 319612, Certificate 246931. No state was given. Pension Card: Henry died 24 May 1928 at Richland, MI.

1850 Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Michael CULLER, age 47 born MD, a farmer; Mary Ann, age 40 MD; Barbary age 18 OH; Joseph H, age 17 OH; Mary E. age 15 OH; Sarah age 14 OH; Henry H, age 9 OH; Martin L, age 7 OH; Michael L, age 4 OH; Margaret E. age 2.

IGI at Family Search includes a sibling Luther Ira, third in line in the children. It also states that the parents were Michael Long CULLER and Mary Ann ERNSBERGER and that Henry was born in Richland County OH.

1860 census Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Mary Ann CULLER, age 48, manages a farm, born MD; Barbara age 27 OH ; Sarah age 25 OH; Henry, a carpenter, age 19 OH; Martin L, a farmer, age 16 OH; Michael age 14 OH; Simon [?] N. age 14 OH.

Richland County probate court record: Henry H. CULLER married Mary E. HOSSINGER 10 Jan 1867 in Richland county OH.

??1870 Census, Mohican Twp, Ashland County OH, page 700: Henry CULLER, age 27 OH, a farmer; Mary, age 26 OH; Mary, age 3 OH; Sarah E, age 1 OH.

Culler, age 39 OH, farmer, parents born MD; Mary E., wife, age 36 OH, parents born PA; Marion O., son, age 12 OH; Sarah E., daughter, age 11 OH; Virtie E., daughter, age 9 OH; Olive M., daughter, age 5 IN; Mary L, daughter, age 2 IL; John R, son, age 1 IL; David TROXIL, nephew, age 20 OH, parents born OH; James UPTON, other, age 18 IN, parents born IN, farmer servant.

1900 Census, Baltimore Twp, Barry Co, MI, page 81: Henry H. CULLER, age 59 OH, born May 1841, married 33 yrs, father born MD, mother born PA, farmer; Mary E., wife, age 56 OH, born Dec 1843, married 33 yrs, 7 children/7 still living, father born Germany, mother born PA; Burtie E. , daughter, age 29 OH, single, servant, born Jun 1870; Bruce, son, age 20 IL, single, born Jul 1879, farm laborer; Dasie, daughter, age 18 IL, born Nov 1881.

Kalamazoo Gazette, 25 Oct 1905, page 2:

"Ralph D. Skidmore and Miss Daisy L. Culler were married at the court house yesterday by Justice Fred Mills. The witnesses were the brother and sister of the bride. Mr. Skidmore is a mail carrier at Hastings and his bride accompanied him to that city last night. Mrs. Skidmore is a daughter of Henry Culler of Richland. The wedding party drove from Richland early yesterday."

1910 Census, Comstock Twp, Kalamazoo Co, MI, page 67: Henry H. CULLER, age 68 OH, married 48 yrs, farmer, father born PA, mother born MD; Mary E., wife, age 67 OH, married 48 yrs, 7 children/7 still living, parents born PA; Verta E, daughter, age 34 OH, single.

Kalamazoo Gazette, 4 April 1918, page 5:

"Richland, April 4. --A reunion of the Culler family took place at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Culler of Campbell's lake, Easter Sunday. Their seven children, also several grandchildren, were present. Others present were: Mr. and Mrs. Otis Culler and daughter, Jennie Schulte of Augusta; Mr. and Mrs. Ralph Skidmore of Battle Creek; Mrs. Frank Brayton, Stanton; Mrs. J. M. Wuggazer, Tawas City; Mrs. Orton Litchy, Hastings; Miss Vesta Culler, Campbell's lake; Mrs. Bruce Culler and family of Richland, and Mr. and Mrs. Carl Brayton of Hartford, Mich."
