DAY, Leonidas* 26 Sept 1862

Private Day was 18 when he entered service. He died 17 Mar 1863 on a hospital boat near Milliken's Bend, Louisiana.

In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Leonidas DAY is listed on the following page as being born 17 Mar 1844, son of Emulous DAY and Elizabeth CONWELL. The family was from Richland and Crawford counties in Ohio.

1850 Census, Washington Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 118, Family 118: E. H. DAY, age 42 NJ, farmer; Elizabeth, age 35 OH; Sophia, age 12 OH; Seneth, age 11 OH; John J, age 8 OH; Leanadith, age 5 OH; James H., age 3 OH.

1860 Census, Johnson Twp, Maries Co MO, Dwelling 801, Family 790: E. H. DAY, age 51 NJ, shoemaker; Elizabeth, age 44 OH; John, age 18 OH farmer; Leander, age 15 OH, farmer; James, age 13 OH.

In 1870 Census, Leonidas' parents were living in Crestline, Crawford County OH. Emulus H DAY, age 61 NJ, blacksmith; Elisabeth, age 55 OH; Sophia FLEMING, age 32 OH, widow; Flora E FLEMING, age 10 MO.
