DEAN, Minor H.* 11 Aug 1862 Minor Hartford DEAN

Corporal Dean was 19 when he entered service. He died 17 Feb 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.
