DUNCAN, Aaron 5 Aug 1862 Aaron David DUNCAN

Private Duncan was 26 when he entered service. He was discharged 25 Aug 1863 at New Orleans, Louisiana on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Pension Index: Aaron DUNCAN, B 120th OH Inf. Invalid filed 1884 June 10, Application 515151, Certificate 466362, filed in Missouri. Widow, Margaret DUNCAN, filed 1912 Feb 16, Application 980699, Certificate 740513, filed in Kansas.

Pension Card: Aaron died 6 Feb 1912 at Desota, KS.

Family Search says that Aaron David DUNCAN was born 3 Feb 1834 at Newville, Richland County OH and that died 6 Feb 1912 in Desoto, Kansas and is buried in Kansas City, Missouri.

1850 District 127, Worthington Township, Richland County OH: Samuel DUNKEN, age 39 born PA, a farmer; Margaret age 33 OH; Aaron, age 16 OH, a farmer; John age 13 OH; Rachel age 10 OH; Hannah age 8 OH; Easter A. age 6 [female]; Samuel age 4 OH. [Neighbors to the Joseph BUTTERSBAUGH family with a daughter Margaret.]

1860 census: Monroe township, Richland county OH, Dwelling 185: Aaron DUNCAN age 24 born in OH, living with Jacob and Jane MANNER.

Richland County Probate Court Marriage Records: Aaron DUNCAN married Margaret A. MUTTERSBAUGH on 22 Oct 1862. [Note: Should be BUTTERBAUGH. In 1860 Margaret BUTTERBAUGH age 16 was living with her mother Sarah BUTTERBAUGH in Worthington township, Richland county, OH. Other researchers say BUTTERBAUGH.]

1870 census: Tipton City, Centre Township, Iowa: Aaron DUNCAN age 34 born OH, laborer; Margaret age 25 born OH, Aaron age 7 born OH, Sarah F age 5 born OH, Emma age 2 born IA, John age 4 months born IA.

1880 census: 4th Ward, Kansas City, Jackson, Missouri: Aaron DUNCAN age 46 born OH a laborer, [parents born OH]; Margaret age 37 born OH; Aaron age 18 born OH, a huckster; Florence [daughter...not listed in 1870] age 15 born OH; Emma, age 12 born IA; John age 10 born IA.

Have not found in 1890 Veterans Schedule.

1900 Census, Lexington Twp, Johnson County, Kansas, page 43; Aaron DUNCAN, age 66 OH, born Feb 1834, married 37 yrs, parents born PA, a farmer; Margaret, wife, age 56 OH, born Jan 1844, married 37 yrs, 5 children/4 still living, parents born PA.

1910 Census, DeSoto City, Lexington Twp, Johnson County, Kansas, page 39: Aron DUNCAN, age 76 OH, first marriage, married 44 yrs, general farmer, father born USA, mother born OH; Margret, wife, age 66 OH, first marriage, married 44 yrs, 5 children/4 still living, parents born PA. [Note: Column 30 indicates UA for military service for Aron.]

DEATHS IN KANSAS CITY.

Aaron DUNCAN died last night in DeSoto, Kas., where he went from Kansas City, Mo., five years ago. He had

been a resident of this city for thirty years. He was 78 years old and leaves a wife and four children: A. P. DUNCAN of Kansas City; J. H. DUNCAN of Independence; Mrs. Florence HARTLEY and Mrs. Emma WHITE, both of Oklahoma City, Ok.

Kansas City Star, 7 Feb 1912, page 2:

"Aaron Duncan Dies in De Soto. Word was received in Kansas City today of the death of Aaron Duncan, 78 years old, at his home in De Soto, Kas., yesterday. He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Margaret Duncan; two daughters, Mrs. Florence Hartley and Mrs. Emma White of Oklahoma City, and two sons, A. P. Duncan, 3228 Bellefontaine Avenue, and J. H. Duncan, Independence, Mo. Funeral services will be at Eylar's chapel, 1401 Main Street, at 2:30 o'clock tomorrow afternoon. The Rev. M. W. Barcafer will officiate. Burial will be in Forest Hill Cemetery."
