Private Ferguson was 33 when he entered service. He died 15 Sept 1863 at New Orleans, Louisiana. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried in Chalmette, Louisiana in Monument Cemetery.

Martha O. SHONT married Charles B. FERGUSON on 21 Oct 1854 by Elnathan SWEET, Minister of the Gospel. Both were from Hancock Mass. But they were married in Stephentown, Rensselaer Co, NY.

New York, State Census, 1855, Watervliet, Albany County, NY, Family 34: Charles FERGUSON, age 23, spinner, birthplace unknown, native; Martha O. FERGUSON, wife, age 23, born Rensselaer Co. Resident in county 2 months.

Lived for awhile in Springfield, OH.

1860 Census, Monroe Twp., Richland Co., OH, dwelling 28, family 28: C.B. FURGERSON, age 29 VA, manufactr; Martha O. FURGISON, age 29 VA, manufactr; Ca(t)herine, age 3 VA; George, age 9 months OH. [C.B. Furgerson, dwelling 28, family 28, appears at the bottom of page 4 (handwritten) of the Monroe Twp. records. At *Ancestry* this page appears as image #8. Martha O. Furgison and the kids, all of whom are also listed at dwelling 28, family 28, appear at the top of page 5 (handwritten) of the Monroe Twp. records. However, at *Ancestry*, this page appears as image #1. *Ancestry* has been notified that the pages are out of order. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

1883 Pensioners, Richland Co., OH, p. 292: Certificate #53,555. Martha O. FERGUSON, Lucas P.O., widow, receives \$8.00 monthly. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

1870 Census Lucas, Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Mary FERGUSON, age 26 NY, keeping house; Catherine, age 13 OH; George, age 10 OH; Fanny, age 8 OH.

1880 Village of Lucas, Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Martha O FURGESON, age 40 NY, keeping house, father born NY, mother not given; Fanny M, daughter, age 17 OH, father born Mass, mother born NY.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Martha A FERGUSON, wife of Charles B FERGUSON of Company B was living in Monroe Township, PO Lucas, Richland County OH. Charles died in New Orleans, LA.

Martha died 24 Jan 1894.

Pension at fold3.com :

Charles B. FERGUSON, Private, Co B 120th OH Vols. Enrolled at Monroe [township, Richland Co] OH. Died 17 Sep 1863 at Marine Hospital New Orleans LA. Became ill with inflammation of the bowels (gastritis) on about 4 Sep 1863.

Widow Martha O. FERGUSON, resident of Richland Co OH, post office Lucas. Martha died 24 Jan 1894.

Martha O. SHONT married Charles B. FERGUSON on 21 Oct 1854 by Elnathan SWEET, Minister of the Gospel. Both were from Hancock Mass. But they were married in Stephentown, Rensselaer Co, NY.
