

## Company B, 120<sup>th</sup> OVI

FLEMING, George\* 12 Aug 1862

Private Fleming was 29 when he entered service. He died 21 Mar 1863 on a hospital boat near Milliken's Bend, Louisiana.

In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: Buried in Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Father: John FLEMING

Cemetery: Vicksburg, MS [Not listed on official role for Vicksburg National Cemetery in Warren Co MS; may be buried as an unknown]

Relationship: Brother in law of Leonidis DAY, Co B 120th OVI.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: George FLEMING, Private, Co B 120th OH Inf, died 21 Mar 1863 on floating hospital "Nashville". Cause: debilitas.

*History of Richland County, Ohio: Its Past and Present*, comp. and pub. by A.A. Graham (1880), p. 904: A biographical sketch of John FLEMING, shoemaker, of Barnes [Washington Twp.], reports he married Margery A. TRINDLE in 1831, and that they had five children, viz: Joseph, Mary Ann, George, Jane E. and Thompson. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Future wife's family. 1850 Census, Washington Twp., Richland Co., OH, dwelling 118, family 118: E.H. DAY, age 42 NJ, farmer; Elizabeth, age 35 OH; Sophia, age 12 OH; Seneth, age 11 OH; John J., age 8 OH; Leandith, age 5 OH; James H., age 3 OH. [*FamilySearch*, "Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994." Richland County, v. 3, p. 147: Emilius DAY and Elizabeth CONWELL, Junior, were married 4 Apr 1837 by A. Billings, Minister of the Gospel. Notation by Kerry Kimberly]

1850 Census, Washington Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 108, Family 108: John FLEMING, age 49 PA, farmer; Margy A., age 49 PA; Mary A., age 18 PA; Josh, age 17 PA; Joseph, age 14 OH; Barberrry OLSBOUGH, age 74 PA.

1860 Census, Johnson Twp., Maries Co., MO, dwelling 808, family 797: George PHLEGMING, age 27 PA, carpenter; Sophie, age 22 OH; Florentine, age 3 months MO; John DAY, age 18 OH. [John DAY, brother of Sophia DAY FLEMING, served in the 64th OVI during the Civil War. He died in 1864 at Chattanooga, TN after a gunshot wound led to the amputation of his right leg. George's brother, Joseph, is found at dwelling 807, family 796, where he is listed as age 24, born OH and a shoemaker by occupation. Listed with Joseph is his wife, Assenath (aka Asentha) who was the sister of Sophia DAY FLEMING. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

According to *Richland County, Ohio Cemetery Records*, by the Richland County Chapter of the Ohio Genealogical Society (1981), p. 393: Georgianna FLEMING, daughter of G. & S., is buried at Little Washington Cemetery, Washington Twp., where her stone indicates she died 10 Sep 1863, age six months and sixteen days. 1870 Census, Crestline, Crawford Co OH, Dwelling 68, Family 72: Emulus H. DAY, age 61 NJ, blacksmith; Elisabeth, age 55 OH; Sophia FLEMING, age 32 OH, widow; Flora E FLEMING., age 10 MO.

1880 Census, Crestline, Crawford Co OH, Dwelling 399, Family 420: Elizabeth DAY, age 65 OH, father born VA, mother born MD; Sophia FLEMING, daughter, age 42 OH, father born NJ, mother born OH; Flora FLEMING, age 19 grandchild, age 19 MO, father born PA, mother born OH.

1890 Special Veterans Schedule, Crestline and Jackson, Crawford Co OH: Line 38, House 636, Family 64?: Sophia FLEMING widow of George FLEMING, Co B 120th OH. PO Union OH.

1900 Census, Thoman st, Crestline, Crawford Co OH, Family 136: Sophia FLEMING, age 62 OH, widow, born Mar 1836, 1 child/1 still living, parents born OH; Flora, daughter, age 40 MO, single, born Feb 1860, father

born PA, mother born OH; William G HOOVER, boarder, age 52 OH, single, born Sep 1847, parents born OH, baggage master on railroad.

Widow, Sophia DAY FLEMING is buried at [Crestline-Greenlawn Cemetery](#), Richland Co., OH, where her stone indicates that she died 25 May 1904. See *Find A Grave*, memorial #96095280. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

*Daughter, FamilySearch*, "Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994." Crawford County, v. 16, p.190: Flora E. FLEM(M)ING and William G. HOOVER were married 18 Aug 1904 by J.W.H. Brown, VDM. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Daughter, 1910 Census, Mansfield, Madison Twp., Richland Co., OH, ED 183, sheet 3-B: 239 West Fifth Street, dwelling 77, family 83, Flora E. HOOVER, widow, age 50 MO, no children, father born PA, mother born OH, no occupation given, renting. [Flora was living in the same dwelling as the family of Isiaiah (sic) K. UMBARGER, a 54 year old insurance agent who owned the house. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Daughter's Death record in Ohio. File #79705 (1947). Flora E. HOOVER, widow of W.G. HOOVER, died 28 Dec 1947 at Mansfield OH. She was born 21 Feb 1860 at MO. Her father, George FLEMING, and her mother, Sophia DAY, were both born in Ohio. Burial at Crestline, Richland County. Informant, Mrs. O.F. SHIVELY, Mansfield, OH [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Brother's Death record in Ohio: File #21032 (1916). *Joseph FLEMING* died 17 Mar 1916 at Mansfield, OH. He was born 16 Apr 1836. His father, John FLEMING, and his mother, Margrath TRENDEL, were both born at PA. Burial at Mansfield Cemetery. Informant, Mrs. [E.?] Charles, Mansfield, OH. [It appears that Joseph was not buried at Mansfield Cemetery, but at Little Washington Cemetery, in Washington Twp., Richland County, OH, where his parents and both of his wives are also buried. Pension Index: George FLEMING, Co B 120 OH Inf. , died 21 Mar 1863 at Youngs Point, MS. Died of fever. Another document says that George died of fever on a hospital boat on 20 Mar 1863. Widow, Sophia FLEMING applied 5 May 1863, Application 20572, Certificate 8859. Information from widow's record: Wife: Sophia DAY, 1 May 1863 post office Barnes, Richland Co OH. George Flemming married Sophia Day 24 Mar 1857 at Richland Co OH by A.K. Owen, Minister of the Gospel.

Children under 16 when father died:

Flora E. born 21 Feb 1860; Affidavit of Mary GRAHAM who stated, "...that she is well acquainted with the child of George Fleming...and knows that his only child, under sixteen years of age, ...Flora Fleming born Feby 21 1860 at Marys County Missouri...that she was present [sic] and assisted Mrs. Fleming during her confinement..." 5 Mar 1874, Crawford co OH.

Georgeanna born 23 Feb 1863. Georgeanne died 10 [1 or 13] Sep 1863. Elizabeth DAY testified that "during the year 1863 she resided in Washington Township Richland County Ohio, and affiant further says that Sophia Fleming was residing with her at that time, and sometime during the month of September AD 1863, Georgiana Fleming died, daughter of Sophia Fleming....." Sophia testified that "on February 23th 1863 she was confined with a female child, that the child was afterwards named Georgiana, affiant further says, that her child Georgiana died on the Tenth day of September AD 1863, at the Township of Washington in the County of Richland and State of Ohio, at the House of Elizabeth Day....."

Flora Uretta FLEMING was born in Maurice Co, MO 21 Feb 1860. Elizabeth DAY testified about Flora's birth, that she had visited "her house a few days thereafter." Emule H. DAY testified that his wife "waited upon Sophia Fleming during her confinement..." living in village of Washington, Richland Co OH. Sophia died 25 May 1904. Sophia was living in Crestline, Crawford Co OH in Oct 1866. Only child listed on 27 Oct 1866 was Flora. On 29 Apr 1871, Sophia Fleming was resident of Crestline, Crawford Co OH.
