HAY, David\* 12 Aug 1862

Private Hay was 18 when he entered service. He died 11 Jan 1863 at Arkansas Post, Arkansas. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Arkansas Post, Arkansas.

Cemetery: Arkansas Post, Arkansas [Those soldiers were moved. Have not found David. He could be buried somewhere as an unknown.]

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: David HAY, Private, Co B 120th OH Inf, died 11 Jan 1863 at Regimental Hospital. Cause: typhoid fever.
