HAZLETT, Calvin 9 Aug 1862

1st Sergeant HAZLETT was 31 when he entered service. He was appointed from Sergeant 15 Mar 1863; discharged 29 Aug 1864 at Cleveland Ohio on Surgeons certificate of disability.

Undated "Muster Roll of Captain Joseph P. Rummels Company B, of the One hundred and twentieth Regiment of Ohio Volunteer Infy." Calvin HAZLETT, 1st Sergt., enrolled Aug 8th/62 from Worthington [Twp.] by Capt. Brayton. Enlisted as private. Promoted to 5th Sergt. Sept 10th/62; to 4th Sergt. Dec 9th/62; to 1st Sergt. March 15th/63. On detached service since Dec 24th/64 by order of Gen. Banks. [From the records of the Ohio Adjutant General, available at the Ohio Historical Society, Columbus, Ohio. History of Richland County, Ohio: Its Past and Present, compiled and published by A.A. Graham, 1807-1880, p. 921: A biographical sketch of R.W. HAZLETT identifies Calvin's parents as Samuel and Mary HAZLETT, and reports that Samuel and Mary's children were: Nancy Jane, Robert Wilson, Clarannah, [Calvin], Mary Ann, Andrew H., and Labanah. [Although the bio refers to eight children, only seven were named. Missing from the list was Samuel and Mary's oldest son, Adoniram. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Richland County, Ohio Marriage Records, v. 7, p. 583: Calvin HAZETT (sic) and Catharine McCANKIE were married 24 May 1858 by James Rowland, VDM. The affidavit for their marriage license, completed the same day, bears the signature of Calvin Hazlett. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Richland County, Ohio Cemetery Records, by The Richland County Chapter of the Ohio Genealogical Society (1981), p. 411: At the Bunker Hill Cemetery, in Worthington Twp., there is a listing for *Walter T. HAZLETT*, son of C. and C., who died 4 Mar 1864, at age 2 years, 8 months and 25 days. [At Olin Cemetery, Jones County, IA, on the same stone as his mother, Catharine HAZLETT, is an inscription for T. Walter HAZLETT, which appears to say he died 4 Feb 1864, aged 2 years 6 months and 16 days. See [Find A Grave](#), memorial #29851657. 1870 Census, Rome Twp, Jones Co IA, Dwelling 189, Family 194: Calvin HAZLETT, age 38 OH, hotel keeper; Catharine, age 30 OH; Lilly Ada, age 10 OH; W. S. Grant, age 4 IA; I. O. Lu [female], age 2 IA. [Family Search member: Calvin HAZLETT married Catharine McCONKIE on 24 May 1858 in Richland Co OH.]

Texas, Marriages, 1837-1973: C. HAZLETT married Laura E RITENOUR, 13 Sep 1877, at Grayson Co TX.

1880 Census. North Montgomery Street, 1st Ward, Sherman, Grayson County TX, page 8: Calvin HAZLETT age 48 OH, clerk in store, parents born PA; Laura, wife, age 37 VA, father born VA, mother born PA; Ada, daughter, age 17 IA, parents birthplaces not filled in; Grant, son, age 14 IA; Iola, daughter, age 12 IA. [parents for Grant and Iola born OH and VA].

[In 1880 Ada Hazlett is also listed with John *McCONKIE*, age 80, farmer, in Dayton Twp., Cedar CO., IA, dwelling 107, family 100. There she is identified as John's granddaughter, age 21, born OH, keeping house. Ada married Henry I. Decker in Texas in 1882. She died in 1915 and is buried at Clarence Cemetery, Cedar Co., IA. 1890 Veterans Schedule: Sherman, Grayson Co TX: Line 3, House 38, Family 40, Calvin HAZLETT, 1st Srgt, Co B 120 OH Inf. Post office: Sherman, TX. Discharged on account of heart disease.

1900 Census, West Mulberry St, Precinct 1, Sherman, Grayson County, TX, page 81: Calvin HASLETT, age 67 OH, born Nov 1832, married 35 yrs, landlord, father born PA, mother born VA; Laura, wife, age 58 VA, born May 1842, married 35 yrs, 2 children/2 still living, parents born VA; Lena, daughter, age 18 TX, born June 1881, single, father born PA, mother born VA; Grant, son, age 32 IA, single, born Apr 1868, father born PA, mother born VA, cashier exp?????.

Brother's Death record in Ohio. File #6663 (1916). Adoniram Young HAZLETT, born 11 Dec 1825, died 31 Jan 1916 at Shelby, Sharon Twp., Richland County, and was buried at Bunker Hill. His father, Samuel HAZLETT, and his mother *Mary WILSON*, were both born in PA. Informant Alice HAZLETT, Shelby, OH. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Brother's Death record in Ohio. File #17253 (1910). R.W. HAZLETT, farmer, born 13 Jun 1828, died 3 Mar 1910 at Butler, Worthington Twp., Richland County, and was buried at Bunker Hill.
