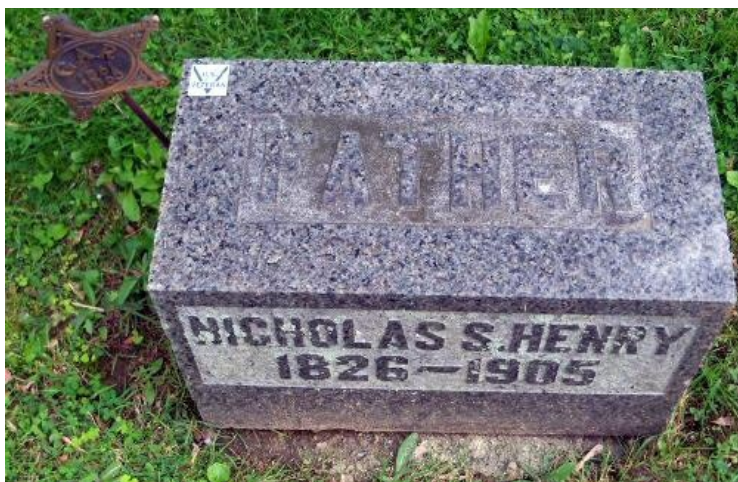
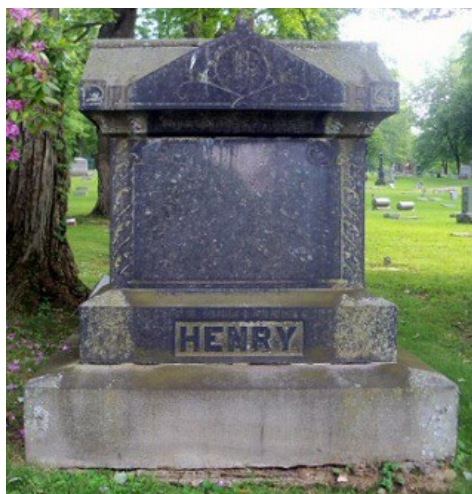

HENRY, Nicholas S. 1 Sept 1862

Wagoner Henry was 34 when he entered service. He was discharged 17 July 1863 at Benton Barracks, Missouri on Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Father: Joseph HENRY

Mother: Margaret ZERCHER

Birth: 16 Dec 1826, Belmont Co OH

Pension Index: Nicholas S HENRY, B 120th OH Inf. Invalid filed 1874 Sep 28, Application 196424, Certificate 253552. Widow, Matilda HENRY, filed in OH 31 Jan 1906, Application 842289, Certificate 641983, filed in OH. Pension Card: Nicholas died 1908[can't be right.

A Centennial Biographical History of Richland Co OH, by Baughman, 1901, pp 224 - 226: Nicholas S. HENRY was born Belmont Co OH, 16 Dec 1826. Nicholas was 9th of 10 children born to Joseph HENRY and Margaret ZERCHER. Joseph died near Lucas, Monroe Twp, Richland Co Oh in 1848. Nicholas married Margaret YATES 10 Feb 1853 in Richland Co OH and had six children: Alexander W., died age 27; Mary P, died age 35; Jessie May, died age 18; Joseph Patrick; Ursula, wife of Joseph P. SCOTT of Fort Wayne IN; Laura L, wife of Alonzo G. WARREN, of Mansfield. Wife Margaret died 12 Dec 1878. Nicholas married Miss Matilda OTT and they had one daughter named Georgia. Their farm at the time of the publishing of the book was in Mifflin Twp, Richland Co OH. Nicholas was a member of Co B, 120th OVI and "on two occasions received serious injuries, which have disabled him largely since leaving the army." Nicholas was six feet, four inches tall. He was a member of the GAR, a Democrat and a Lutheran.

1850 Census, Monroe Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 147, Family 147: David HENRY, age 34 OH, farmer; Jane, age 32 VA; Margaret A., age 12 OH; Martin L, age 9 OH; Emily A., age 8 OH; Rebecca J., age 6 OH; William A, age 3 OH; Elizabeth, age 24 OH; Nicholas, age 23 OH, farmer.

[.....1850 Census District 127 Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Nicholas Henry, age 23 OH, a farmer, was living with David and Jane HENRY. David was 34 OH, so perhaps he was a brother of Nicholas. Also living nearby was Robert HENRY, age 38 OH, perhaps another brother. Also living nearby was Margaret HENRY, age 60 PA. Could this be his mother? Living with her was Sarah, age 27 OH, Mary Ann HARTMAN, age 31 OH, and Eliza HARTMAN, age 13 OH. Could Sarah and Mary Ann be his sisters?]

1860 Census Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Nicholas HENRY, age 32 OH, a farmer; Margaret, age 30 OH; Joseph, age 6 OH; Ursula, age 3 OH; Laura, age one, OH; also living there was Columbus WELSH, age 14.

1870 Census Mifflin Township, Richland County OH: Nicholas HENRY, age 42 OH, a farmer; Margaret, age 40 OH; Joseph, age 15 OH; Ursula?? [female] age 13 OH; Laura, age 11 OH; Alexander, age 9 OH; Mary, age 7 OH.

There is a small bio summary at the following site. He was from Monroe township, Richland county. He was married to Margaret Yates. Children: Joseph Patrick, Ursula Melissa, Laura L., Washington Alexander, Mary P., and Jessie M. The history states that he received an injury at Perkins' Plantation, eleven miles from Richmond.

1880 Census, Mifflin Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 123, Family 133: Nicholas S. HENRY, age 50 OH, marked as single, farmer, parents born PA; Ursula, daughter, single, age 23 OH, parents born OH; Washington A, son, age 19 OH, marked idiotic, single, parents born OH; Mary, daughter, age 17 OH, single, parents born OH; Jessie M, daughter, age 9 OH, parents born OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Mifflin Twp, Richland Co OH: Line 17, House 126, Family 129: Nicholas HENRY of Company B is listed as living in Mifflin Township, Richland County OH. He was a teamster in the war. He had chronic diarrhea and had been injured in the head and back by the falling of a smoke stack of the steamboat "Silver Wave".

1900 Census, Mifflin Twp, Richland Co OH, page 43: Nicholas S. HENRY, age 73 OH, born Dec 1826, married 19 yrs, parents born PA, farmer; Matilda, wife, age 54 IN, born Apr 1846, parents born OH; Georgie E., daughter, age 16 OH, born Aug 1883, father born OH, mother born IN.

Matilda is listed as a widow in 1910.

Son's Death record in Ohio: File # 51955, J. Patrick HENRY died 2 Sep 1910 at Mansfield, Richland Co OH. Born 10 Apr 1854 in OH. Attorney. Father Nichlaus HENRY, born OH. Mother Margratt YATES, born OH. Burial Mansfield OH. Informant Mrs. J. P. HENRY, of Mansfield, OH.

Daughter's Death record in Ohio: File # 17357, Laura L. WALTERS died 5 Mar 1945 at 161 South Franklin Ave., Mansfield, Richland Co OH. Divorced from Warren WALTERS. Born 17 Nov 1858 Richland Co OH. Father Nichols S. HENRY, born PA. Mother Margaret YATES, born PA. Burial Mansfield Cem. Informant, Henry F. SCHWIER?, of Mansfield OH.

Daughter's Death record in Ohio: File # 46247, Ursula M. SCOTT did 4 Aug 1910 at College Place, West 3d, Mansfield, Richland Co OH. Widow. Born 10 Jan 1847 at Richland Co OH. Father Nicholas S. HENRY born PA. Mother Margaret YATES, born OH. Burial Mansfield OH. Informant Mrs. Laura WARREN, of Mansfield, OH.

Wife, Death record in Ohio: File # 68610, Matilda HENRY, of 232 Newman St, died 23 Dec 1924 at Mansfield, Richland Co OH, and is buried in Mansfield Cem. Widow. Husband Nicholas HENRY. Born 5 Apr 1842 in Noble Co IN. Father George OTT, born Noble Co IN. Mother Mary BROWN, born IN. Informant Mrs. O SIGLER of Newman St, Mansfield.
