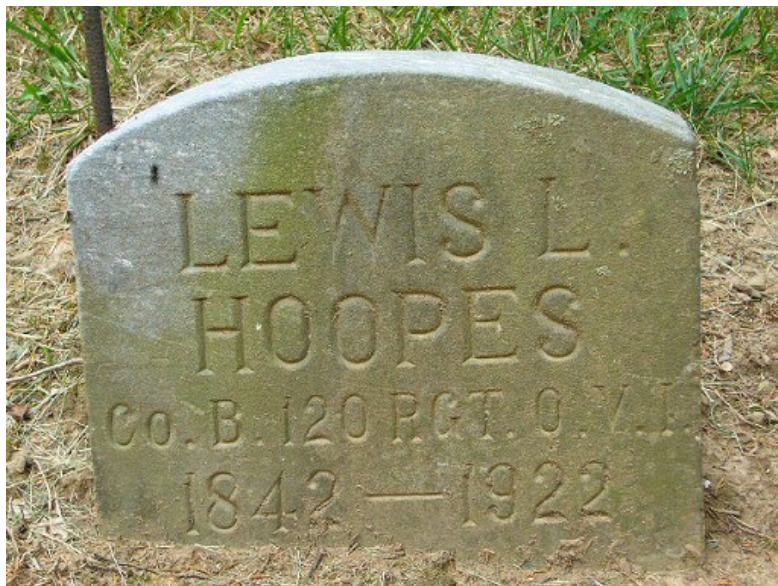

HOOPES, Lewis L. 6 Aug 1862
HOOPS

Private Hoopes was 21 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 8 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Enrolled at Mansfield.

Father: Phineas HOOPES

Mother: Mary ROSWELL

Birth: 20 Apr 1842 OH or Kennett, Chester County PA

Marriage: Phoebe WILLIAMS, 16 Jan 1866 OH

Death: 16 Sep 1922 in Weller Twp, Richland Co OH

Cemetery: Williams Cemetery, Lucas, Richland Co OH

Relationship: Brother of Thomas HOOPES, Co B 120th OVI; brother in law of William P. WILLIAMS, Co B 120th OVI.

Pension Index: Lewis L HOOPS, B 120th and D 114th OH Inf. Invalid filed 1882 Aug 7, Application 456669, Certificate 283210, filed in OH. Died 23 Sep 1922 at Shiloh, OH. This date is different from the Ohio Death Record.

Richland County, Ohio Soldiers Discharges, v. 1, p. 56: Lewis HOOPES, born Cincinnati, Ohio; age 21; 5'6", fair complexion, gray eyes, dark hair; farmer; served under Capt. J.P. Rummel. [Richland County Recorder's Office, Mansfield, Ohio. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly.]

Family Search says Lewis Lambert Hoopes was born 20 Apr 1842 in Kennett, Chester County PA. The siblings were William A, Marshall B, Phebe Ann, Lewis L, Jane H, Alfred, and Thomas J.

But Lewis isn't here. 1850 Census, Fulton Twp, Lancaster Co PA, Dwelling 130, Family 130: Phineas HOOPS, age 39 MD; Mary R., age 35 NJ; Jane G, age 18 PA; William A., age 7 PA; Phebe A., age 5 PA; Aphard [male], age 3 PA; Marshal B, age 1 PA; Ann McKINNEY, age 20 MD.

1860 Census, Butler Twp, Columbiana County, OH, page 46: Phineas HOOPS, age 48 PA, farmer; Mary R, age 44 NJ; William A, age 16 PA, farmer; Phebe A, age 15 PA; Marshall B, age 11 PA. [Lewis is not listed with this family.] [[Mary R HOOPES](#), wife of Phineas is buried at Winona Friends Graveyard, Winona, Columbiana Co OH. Died 1866. Phineas isn't listed.]

In 1860 Census, Lewis may have been living back in London Grove, Chester Co PA. Lewis HOOPES, age 18 Pa, is living with the David and Hannah C HUMES family. Post office Cochranville. This is the interpretation by Ancestry.com. I can't read the record.

Richland County, Ohio Marriage Records, v. 9, p. 280: Lewis HOOPES and Pheba WILLIAMS were married 16 Jan 1866 by H.L. Wiles, minister of the gospel. The marriage affidavit was signed by Lewis HOOPES 12 Jan 1866. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Haven't found in 1870.

1880 Census, Lucas Village, Monroe Twp., Richland Co., OH, p. 116-B, dwelling 48, family 53: Lewis L. HOOPES, age 40 OH, teamster, no place of birth given for parents; Phoebe, wife, age 40 OH, parents born OH; Thomas E., son, age 11 OH; Raymond L., son, age 7 OH; Minnie E., daughter, age 3 OH; Mott L., son, age 1 OH; infant son, born Feb 1880 OH. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly.]

1890 Veterans Schedule: Monroe Twp, Richland Co OH: Line 27, House 82, Family 92: Lewis L. HOOPS, Pvt, of Company B was living in Monroe Township, PO Lucas, Richland County OH.. He had rheumatism. He was a prisoner in the war for 13 months.

1900 Census, Lucas Village, Monroe Twp, Richland County, OH, page 60: Lewis L HOOPES, age 68 OH, born Apr 1842, father born PA, mother born NJ, manager of livery barn; Phoebe, wife, age 61 OH, born Feb 1839, parents born OH; Raymond L, son, age 27 OH, Wd?, born Aug 1872, paper hanger; Mott. L, son, age 21 OH, single, born Dec 1878. R R laborer; Sydney C, son, age 20 OH, single, born Feb 1880, day laborer; Anise B, grand daughter, age 4 OH, born Sept 1895, parents born OH. [R. L. HOOPES married Bertha Tarris, 17 Jun 1900 at Richland Co OH. His parents were L. L. Hoopes and Phoebe Williams.]

1910 Census, Lucas Village, Monroe Twp, Richland County, OH, page 283: Louis HOOPES, age 67 OH, no occupation, first marriage, married 44 yrs, parents born PA; Phoebe, wife, age 71 OH, first marriage, married 44 yrs, 7 children/4 still living, parents born OH; Roy, son, age 31 OH, single, laborer odd jobs; Sidney, son, age 30 OH, single, laborer on farm; Beatrice, granddaughter, age 14 OH, parents born OH.

1920 Census, Lucas, Monroe Twp, Richland County OH, page 123: Lewis HOOPS, age 77 OH, widowed, no occupation, listed as father-in-law in the household of Orron and Minnie BARR.

Son's marriage, Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: R. L. HOOPES, age 27, married Bertha TARRIS, age 21, at Richland OH on 17 Jun 1900. Groom born Lucas, OH. Father L. L. HOOPES. Mother Pheobe WILLIAMS. Bertha born Jefferson Twp, Richland Co OH. Bertha's father John TARRIS. Her mother, Candice SNIDER.

Death record in Ohio: File # 49775 Lewis L HOOPS died 16 Sep 1922 in Weller Twp, Richland Co OH. It says he was a retired "soldier". He was born in Cin? OH 20 Apr 1842. Widowed. Buried at IOOF Cem, Lucas OH. Informant did not know parents names. Informant D O BARR of Shiloh OH, RD2

Brother's Death record in Ohio: File # 72729 Wm A HOOPES died 16 Dec 1916 in Butler Twp, Columbiana Co OH. He was born 13 Sept 1843 in PA. His father was Phineas HOOPES born PA. His mother was Mary ROSWELL. Farmer. He was still married. Burial Damascus Cem. Informant was Mrs Wm HOOPES, Salem OH.

Sister's Death record in Ohio: File # 21219, Phoebe Ann CREW died 5 Mar 1931 at Center Twp, Columbiana County, at the County Home. Widow of Mahlon CREW. Born 18 Apr 1845 at PA. Father Phineas HOOPES born PA. Mother Mary ROSSELL, born PA. Burial Damascus Cem. Informant Mrs. Ida M. LADD of Damascus, OH.
