HOOPES, Thomas J. 8 Aug 1862

Sergeant Hoopes was 25 when he entered service. He was appointed from Corporal 1 Mar 1863; discharged 24 July 1864, at Morganzia, Louisiana on Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Brother of Lewis HOOPES. Family search says Thomas Jackson HOOPES was born 14 Sep 1836 in New Garden, Chester County Pa and died in Des Moines, Polk County IA. Thomas Jackson HOOPES married Lousa Sena STRATTON on 4 Mar 1860 in Columbiana County OH. Family Search says Lewis Lambert Hoopes [above] was born 20 Apr 1842 in Kennett, Chester County PA. The siblings were William A, Marshall B, Phebe Ann, Lewis L, Jane H, Alfred, and Thomas J.
