HUNT, Samuel* 11 Aug 1862

Private Hunt was 24 when he entered service. He died 21 Jan 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana.
In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

1870 Census, Mifflin Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 8, Family 9: Jacob HUNT, age 37 OH, farmer; Abbigail, age 25 IL; Alice, age one OH; [next page] Daniel 80 PA, farmer: Sarah, age 74 NJ; Isabell, age 47 PA, no occupation; Susan, age 43 PA, no occupation.

Neither Daniel nor Sarah are living with Jacob in 1880.
