HUSTON, Jeremiah 12 Aug 1862

Private Jeremiah Huston was 28 when he entered service. He was transferred to 120th Company, 2d Battalion, Veteran Reserve Corps 15 Dec 1863; discharged 29 Feb 1864 at Indianapolis, Indiana on Surgeon's certificate of disability.
