KITHCART, Thomas W. 17 Oct 1863  
Private Kithcart was 18 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. E, 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co D, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 9 May 1866.

Marriage: Sarah L. WHITE, 25 Dec 1867 at Miami Co., IN

Researcher at WorldConnect: Father, Joseph KITHCART, mother Mary J. WHITE. Thomas died 1916 in Hebron IN and is buried in Hebron Cem, Hebron, Porter Co IN. It says that wife Sarah was also buried there.

Nearest relative: sister Martha Wygant, Roanoke, IN

Died of apoplexy while away from the Home; died at Roanoke, IN, on 10 Aug 1916.

Burial at Hebron, IN on 12 Aug 1916, W. M. Korntz, undertaker, Roanoke, IN
