LICKLITER, George W.* 6 Aug 1862 George Washington LICKLITER
Private Lickliter was 34 when he entered service. He died 16 Mar 1863 on a hospital boat near Milliken's Bend, Louisiana. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: George W. LICKLIGHTER, Private, Co B 120th OH Inf.
Died 18 Mar 1863 on floating hospital "Nashville." Cause diarrhoea and icterus [jaundice]

Have not found in Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Pension Index: George W. LICKLITER, Co B 120th OH Inf. Widow Mary J. LICKLITER applied for 6 July 1863, Application 26621, Certificate 11294, filed in OH. Minor guardian, David McFarland, applied for 7 Aug 1865, Application 104861, Certificate 92540.

Pension document 22 Apr 1863, Widow's Declaration: Mary Jane Lickliter married George W. Lickliter 5 Sept 1850 at Richland Co OH. Her maiden name was Mary Jane BURKE. Her residence in 1863 was Washington village, Richland Co OH.

1850 Census, Monroe Twp., Richland Co., OH, dwelling 29, family 29: William HAFFORD, age 23 VA, farmer; Mary, age 25 VA; Sarah E., age 19 OH; Washington LICKLIDER, age 23 VA, farmer. [Though the name is clearly recorded as "Hafford" in this census, other records point to this being the family of William J. and Mary M. (LICKLITER) STAFFORD and their daughter Sarah Elizabeth, who was really only a year old in 1850. It is likely that Mary is a sister of George Washington LICKLITER. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

1860 Census, Monore Twp, Richland County, OH, Dwelling 85, Family 86 : Geo W LECKLEITER/LICKLEITER, age 32 VA, day laborer; Mary F, age 28 OH; Mary R, age 7 OH; James C, age 5 OH; Martha A, age 8 OH; Williard H, age 11 months OH.

[Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: Mary J. LICKITER married Joseph FERGUSON on 2 Apr 1865 in Richland Co OH.]

1880 Census, Berlin Twp, Knox Co OH, Dwelling 30, Family 30: W. LECKLITER, age 21 OH, father born PA, mother born OH, single, laborer.....is living with Willard W and Alice R COLE and family.

1880 Census, Berlin Twp, Knox Co OH, Dwelling 28, Family 28: James LECKLITER, single, age 25 OH, father born PA, mother born OH, laborer.....is living with WM W. COLE and Elizabeth M COLE and family.

Son George, Ohio, Deaths and Burials, 1854-1997: G. C. LECHLITER died 1 Feb 1893 at Mt. Vernon, Knox Co OH, age 30. Born about 1863 in Richland Co OH. Occupation: mohler[might be a mistake in transcription]. Married. Father G. W. LECHLITER. Mother Mary J. BURK.

Is this son, Willard and grandson Roy? Ohio, Deaths and Burials, 1854-1997: Roy D. LECKLITER, Sr. Died 1 Dec 1962 at Mount Vernon, Knox Co OH. Age 76, born <1886>. Father Willard LECKLITER. Mother Elizabeth ZIMMERMAN.

Daughter: Ohio, Deaths, 1908-1953: [Martha Ann ERRETT](#) died 14 Feb 1926 at Akron, Summit Co OH, residence 829 Amherst. Age 69, widowed. Born 17 Sep 1856, OH. Burial at Mt. Vernon, OH. Father W. B. LICKLETER, born MD. Mother Mary BURK, born OH. Spouse: George. [Mound View Cemetery, Mount Vernon, Knox Co OH.] [George and Martha ERRETT were living in Mt Vernon, Knox Co OH in 1880 and 1900. They had been married <1875>.] [Ohio, County Marriages 1789-1994: Geo E. ERRETT married Mattie A. LECKLITER, 8 Mar 1877 at Knox Co OH.]

Pension at fold3.com :

George W. LICKLITER, Private, Co B 120th OH Reg, died at Youngs Point LA, 20 Mar 1863 of chronic diarrhoea. He enrolled at Monroe, Richland Co OH. Died of fever on hospital boat, 22 Mar 1863. Died on floating hospital "Nashville" of diarrhoea and icterus [jaundice]. Another paper said he died 18 Mar 1863.

George and Mary Jane BURK married 5 Sep 1850 at Newville, Richland Co OH.

Widow, Mary Jane LICKLITER [dated 22 Apr 1863] was age 32, resident of Washington village, Richland Co OH.

Widow remarried Joseph W. FERGUSON, 2 Apr 1865, Richland Co OH

Guardian David McFARLAND, of Washington Twp, Richland co OH, age 55 [dated 1 Aug 1865]

Children:

Mary A. J. LECKLITER, born 11 Aug 1852, nurse was Arabell HEYSER.(physician now dead, not named)

James C. LECKLITER, born 1 Nov 1854, Matilda A. COUTER attended the mother but Dr. Cominger was in attendance [Dr. moved west]

Martha A. LECKLITER, born 17 Sep 1856, attending physician was John M. SMITH

Nathan W. (William H.) LECKLITER, born 6 July 1859, attending was Elizabeth ARMSTRONG

George C. LECKLITER, born 3 Apr 1864, attending physician was N. BAKER.
