LIKES, George C. 11 Aug 1862

Private Likes was 24 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. E 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864.

Transferred to Co E, 48th OVI. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

According to an undated "Muster Roll of Captain Joseph P. Rummel's Company B of the One hundred and twentieth Regiment of Ohio Volunteer Infy"

George C. LIKES, Private, was enrolled Aug. 11"/62 at Worthington [Twp.] by Lieut.

Rummel. [From the file of the Ohio Adjutant General at the Ohio Historical Society. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Marriage: Christena STINE, 17 Feb 1867, Richland Co OH

Death: 28 Nov 1879, Norton, Jefferson Co KS

Cemetery: Hull Grove Cemetery, Winchester, Jefferson Co KS, 42 yrs, 7 mths, 3 dys.

Find a Grave tombstone: Christina STINE was later married to George COOK. She was born Aug 14, 1847, died June 9, 1923.

Have not found on Pension Index.

[In 1840 both the father John LEIX and the grandfather George LEIX were in Mohican Twp, Wayne Co OH. In 1846 Mohican Twp became part of Ashland Co OH.]

Where was George, age 23?? 1860 Census, Hanover, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling , Family: John LIKES, age 45 PA, farmer; Abigail, age 47 OH; Jacob, age 19 OH; Joseph, age 18 OH; Sarah A, age 12 OH; Mary M, age 7 OH. [Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: John LEIX married Abby CHILDS on 30 Jun 1836 at Wayne Co OH.] [Was this another sibling? Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: Christena LEIX married David SHOWALTER, 17 Feb 1846 at Wayne Co OH.] John and Abigail ended up in Berrien Co MI. Abigail is there in the 1880 Census living with son Jacob C. [According to *Richland County, Ohio Cemetery Records* (1981), p. 411, there is (or at least there was) a stone at Bunker Hill Cemetery, Worthington Twp., for **John LIKES** who **died 6 Dec 1861, at age 47 yrs, 9 mos, 28 days.** Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Ohio Marriages: George C. LIKES married Christena STINE, 17 Feb 1867, Richland Co OH

1870 Census, Worthington Twp, Richland Co., OH, dwelling 90, family 91: George LIKES, age 31 OH, farm laborer; Christena, age 21 OH; Ida, age 2 OH; Anna, born Apl 1870, OH. [This one was misspelled "Sikes" in the Ancestry.com index. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly.]

Move to Jefferson Co KS <1872>

Kansas State Census dated 1 Mar 1875, Jefferson, Jefferson Co KS, Family 169: George C. LYKES, age 37 OH, farmer; Christene, age 27 OH; Mary A., age 5 OH; Love Ann, age 2 KS. Note: From a combination of records, including her marker at the Reformed Presbyterian Cemetery in Jefferson Co., KS, it is clear that her name was actually "Lovie Ann" (see Lovie Ann LIKES SHUGHART at findagrave.com). Lovie Ann married Jacob Finley Shughart. She appears in several census records as Lovie Ann/Lovie A. Shughart; she died in

1956, and she is buried at Reformed Presbyterian Cemetery in Jeffersn Co., KS. Her sister, Mary Alice, married Andrew Shughart, died in 1952 and is buried in the same cemetery. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

1880 Census, Norton, Jefferson Co KS, Dwelling 196, Family 197: Christine LIKES, listed as "married", age 30 OH, parents born Germany; Alice, daughter, age 10 OH; Anna, daughter, age 7 KS. Children's parents bron OH.

Federal Census Mortality Schedule, 1850-1885: 31 May 1880 Norton, Jefferson Co KS, Line 14 197 Geo. C. LIKES, age 42, married, born OH, parents born PA. Farmer. Died Nov of typhoid pneumonia. 7 yrs resident of county.

Kansas, Marriages, 1840-1935: Christina LIKES married George W. COOK at Oskaloosa, Jefferson Co KS on 23 Mar **1882**. She was age 32, born <1850>. He was age 32, born <1850>.

1900 Census, Jefferson, Jefferson Co KS, Dwelling 190, Family 191: George W. COOK, age 61 IN, born June 1838, married 18 yrs, father born OH, mother born IN, farmer; Christine A. , wife, age 51 OH, born Aug 1848, married 18 yrs, 5 children/4 still living, paretns born Germany; David C., son, age 16 KS, born Apr 1884, single, father born IN, mother born OH, at school; Edward E, son, age 10 KS, born Mar? 1890, father born IN, mother born OH, at school.

1910 Census Jefferson Twp, Jefferson Co KS, Dwelling 221, Family 231: George W. COOK, age 71 IN, second marriage, married 28 yrs, parents born IN, general farming, not marked for military service; Christina A., wife, age 62 OH, second marriage, married 28 yrs, 5 children/4 still living; parents born Germany; Edward E, son, age 20 KS, single, farm laborer.

George W. Cook, Co I 11th Cavalry, died 29 Aug 1913. Pension Index: George W. COOK, Co I, 11th KS Cav. Invalid Pension: 17 May 1888, Application 655275, Certificate 430718, filed in KS. Widow, Christina A. COOK, filed 15 Sep 1913, Application 1014364, Certificate 772748, filed in KS.

1920 Census, Jefferson Twp, Jefferson Co KS, Dwelling 64, Visited 64: Christina COOK, widowed, age 72 OH, parents born Germany, no occupation.
