LUTZ, Jacob M.* 11 Aug 1862

Private Lutz was 20 when he entered service. He died 30 Jan 1863 on the steamer Omaha at Young's Point, Louisiana. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

1860 Census, Hanover Twp, Ashland County, OH, page 66: Samuel LUTZ, age 47 PA, farmer; Louisa, age 44 PA; Roxana, age 23 OH; **Jacob, age 18 OH**; Samuel, age 11 OH; Mary Jane, age 7 OH; Henry C, age 4 OH; Margaret E, 11 months OH.

[Parents, Samuel died in 1871 and Louisa in 1885 and were buried at Bunker Hill Cem, Richland Co OH.]

Brother's Death record in Ohio: File # 28103, Henry Clark LUTZ died 15 May 1935 in Loudonville, Ashland Co OH. Married, wife Lenora Thomas Lutz. Born 15 Jan 1856 in OH. Father Samuel LUTZ, born PA.
