 Private Elliott Miller was 18 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. E 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co D, 48th OVI, 24 July, 1865. Mustered out 9 May 1866 at Galveston TX.  
 Father: ???Samuel MILLER  
 Mother: ???Eleanor ROBINSON  
 Birth: <1845>  
 Marriage: There was a pension for a minor child, so Elliott must have been married.  
 Death: 27 Apr 1873  
 Cemetery: Perrysville Union Cemetery, Ashland Co OH

Sons of Union Veterans: Service also lists Co. D in the 48th OVI and Co G in the 7th TN Inf. [Note: He is not listed at Soldiers and Sailors System as being in the 7th TN.] Burial Presbyterian Cem, Bridge and Church Sts, Perrysville, Green Twp, Ashland County OH.

??1850 Census, Mohican Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 189, Family 192: Samuel MILLER, age 64 PA, farmer; Eleanor, age 61 PA; Alonzo H, age 18 PA; Sarah N?, age 16 PA; Nancy E, age 16 OH; Nelly A, age 12 OH; Rebecca I?, age 10 OH; Nelson, age 8 OH; Asberry [male], age 6 OH; Eliott, age 6 OH; Brown, age 3 OH. [Note: were these younger children actually the children of Samuel and Eleanor? Or were Samuel and Eleanor the grandparents?]

??1860 Census, Hanover Twp, Ashland County OH, page 64 : John OHLER, age 35 OH, farmer; Jane, age 32 OH; Sarah, age 10 OH; Elliot MILLER, age 12 OH.

1870 Census, have not found. But it looks like Elliott died in 1873. I can't find anything about his being in Company C, 7<sup>th</sup> TN Infantry [see stone application below], but the stone

in the Cemetery looks like it says Company C. And the GAR flag holder next to it shows Company B, 120<sup>th</sup> OVI.

??Sister's death record in Ohio File # Sarah M. HAZLETT died on 20 June 1914 at Lucas Co Hospital, Toledo, Lucas Co OH. Married. Birth date unknown. Age 78 [<1836>]. Parents, Samuel MILLER and Elenor ROBINSON, born PA. Burial Washington Twp, Wood Co OH.
