Transferred to Co E, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

1860 Worthington Township, Richland County, OH: James MORRISON age 52 born PA, a farmer, Ruth age 51, born VA; Samuel age 19 OH a farmer; Solomon age 15 OH, a farmer; Caroline age 13 OH; Emily age 10 OH; Connell age 8 OH; Ella age 6 OH. Also living there was Lydia Cole age 37. WorldConnect lists Solomon's mother as Ruth Ann BILLINGS.

1870 Webster City, Hamilton County, IA: Solomon MORRISON age 24, born OH, a laborer, is living with John [wife Sarah] PATTERSON, a dry goods and retail grocer.

"For many years the business of the town was conducted largely by Sol. Morrison, J. C. McNee, \_\_\_\_\_Brown, W. F. Powers, G. A. Walrath and Wilse McNee."

"February, 1882, when a disastrous fire occurred, sweeping out of existence at one more than half of the business part of the town, taking all of the business buildings on the west side of Main street except two. The fire started in Pat Maloy's saloon. In about an hour's time the town was in ruins. The principal losers were the Martin estate, S. S. Morrison, Pat Maloy, Mrs. Ann Carus, Fred Volenweider, J. M. George, A. Rawhorter, J. M. Houghtaling, Chas. Draper, Frost & Co., Willis Orres and J. W. Thompson."

1900 Blairsburg Township, Hamilton County IA: Solomon S. MORRISON age 54, born Feb 1846 OH, a general merchant, married 25 years, father born PA, mother VA; Lidia A, wife, age 50 born Feb 1850 in PA, married 25 yrs, 2 children, 2 still living; Mary, daughter, age 24 IA, born May 1876, single.

1910 Webster City, Boone Township, Hamilton County IA: Solomon S. MORRISON, age 62 OH, first marriage, married 36 yrs, own income, lists both parents as born in PA; Lidean C., wife, age 58 PA, parents born PA, married 36 yrs, first marriage, 2 children both still living.

1920 Webster City, Boone Township, Hamilton County IA: L.C. MORRISON, age 68, a widow, living alone, born PA, parents born PA.
