MOWERS, Henry H. 8 Aug 1862
Sergeant Henry Mowers was 24 when he entered service. He was wounded 1 May 1863 in battle of Thompson's Hill, Mississippi; discharged 15 July 1863. [Note: another source says he was captured at Millikens Bend and James Plantation, LA.]

Pension Index: Henry H MOWERS, B 120th. Invalid filed 18 Sep 1863. Application 32855, Certificate 29512. Widow, Melinda MOWERS, filed 1932 Mar 9, Application 1713612, Certificate A-7-20-32, no state given. Pension Card: Henry died 29 Feb 1932 at Grover Hill, OH.

In the 28 May 1863 issue of the Wooster Republican it was reported that H.H. Mowers was wounded in the left arm and right hand.

1860 Census Monroe Township, Richland County OH; Isaac MOWER, age 57 VA, farmer; Marie, age 48, born Germany; Henry H, age 21 OH, carpenter; John H, age 19 OH, a carpenter [See John below]; Sarah, age 18 OH, a teacher; Martin L, age 16 OH, a farmer; Elizabeth age 14 OH; Julia Ann, age 12 OH; George, age 9 OH; Lucinda, age 6 OH; William, age 3 OH; Also living there Elizabeth ?Manner age 22 OH, a domestic.

1864: Richland County Probate Court record: Henry H MOWERS married Malinda CULLER on 13 Oct 1864 in Richland County OH.

Have not found in 1870 and 1880.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Montgomery, Ashland Co OH: Line 21, House 148, Family 153: Henry H. MOWERS, Private, Co C [incorrect] 120 OH Inf. Post Office: Ashland OH. No comments.

1900 Washington Township, Paulding County OH: Henry MOWER, age 61 OH, born July 1839, married 35 yrs, a farmer, father born VA, mother Germany; Malinda, wife, age 60, born Oct 1839 in OH, married 35 yrs, 4 children, 4 still living, father born MD, mother OH; Harvy or Harry STAHL, son-in-law, a farmer, age 32, born Mar 1868, married 2 yrs, father born VA, mother born OH; Anna, daughter, age 21, born Nov 1878, married 2 yrs, 1 child, 1 still living; Floid, grandson, age 11 months, born July 1899 in OH.

1910 Census Grover Hill Village, Latty Township, Paulding County OH, page 205: Henry H MOWERS, age 71 OH, half owner of tile factory, first marriage, married 45 years, father born VA, mother Germany; Melinda, age 60 OH, first marriage, married 45 yrs, 4 children, 4 still living, father born MD, mother OH. [Note: Column 30 is marked UA for military service for Henry.]

1920 Census Harrison Street, Grover Hill Village, Latty Township, Paulding County OH: Henry H MOWERS, age 81; Malinda, wife, age 80. Birthplace information is the same as the 1910 census. Henry is no longer working.

Sons of Union Veterans: Burial Mt. Zion Cem, Mt Zion Rd, Monroe Twp, Richland County OH. Died 1932.

Death record in Ohio: Henry H MOWERS, died 29 Feb 1932 in Latty Twp, Paulding County, OH. He was born 3 Jul 1838 in OH. His parents were Isaac MOWERS, born VA, and Anna KYLER, born Germany. His wife was Malinda MOWERS. Informant was ??? STAHL of Grover Hill, OH. Henry was in the Army. He was retired. Burial in Mt Zion Cem, Lucas, OH.
