NORICK, David* 9 August 1862 NORRICK

Private Norick was 30 when he entered service. He died 27 Mar 1863 on a hospital boat near Milliken's Bend, Louisiana. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Mother: Mary Elizabeth WICKFIELD

Birth: 9 Oct 1831, Harrison OH

Marriage: Mary F. NEWTON or NEWLON, 20 Jan 1857 Richland Co OH

Death: 27 Mar 1863, hospital boat, "Nashville", near Milliken's Bend, LA

Cemetery: Vicksburg, MS: Not listed anywhere in Vicksburg Nat'l Cem. Probably buried as an unknown.]

Pension Index: David M NORRICK, B 120th OH Inf. Widow, Mary F NORRICK, filed 1863 May 1, Application 20080, Certificate 61398. .

This may be wife Mary: Mary NORICK died 2 Apr 1900 in Mansfield, Richland Co OH, age 67, born 1833, widow. Ohio EASy, film 397773, V. 1, p. 53 [Note: I haven't found her in the 1900 Census, and according to other census records she was born about 1833.]

Family Search says that David NORRICK was born 9 Oct 1831 and died 26 Mar 1863 in Vicksburg. His parents were Daniel and Mary Elizabeth [WICKFIELD] NORRICK. He was married 20 Jan 1857 in Richland County OH.

Richland County Probate Court record: David M. NORRICK married Mary F. NEWLON on 20 Jan 1857 in Richland OH.

1860 Washington Township, Richland County OH: David NORWICH, age 27 born OH, a farmer; Mary, age 27 OH; Josiah, age 2 OH; baby, age one month OH. [They were living in the dwelling next to Daniel NORRICK, age 63 PA, a farmer; Elizabeth age 63 VA; Margaret age 17 OH.]

Have not found widow in 1870.

1880 Census Washington Township, Richland County OH: Mary NORRICK, age 47, born OH, parents born VA; Josiah NORRICK, son, age 21 OH, a farmer; Julia A. McFARLAND, other, age 48, OH, a seamstress, father born PA, mother born NY.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Line 5, House 267, Family 275: Mary Norrick, widow of David M. Norrick, Pvt, Co B 120 OVI. Post Office: Mansfield city. No comments.

Ohio, Deaths and Burials, 1854-1997: Mary NORICK, died 2 Apr 1900 at Mansfield, Richland Co OH, age 67.

Pension at fold3.com :

David M. NORRICK, Private, Co B 120th OH Vols, died of fever on hospital boat, "Nashville", 25 Mar 1863 of camp diarrhoea and debilitas. Another date shows his death 26 Mar 1863. David enrolled at Monroe, Richland Co OH.

David had become sick with fever and then diarrhoea [15 to 20 times per day] in Feb 1863, and on 7 Mar 1863 David was placed on the hospital boat "Nashville" at Youngs Point. He was "much reduced and

emaciated from the disease."[Hiram McCREARY affidavit] "...there was but little more than skin and bones left of him..."[William SWAN affidavit] He was at Millikens Bend, LA, some seven miles up the river from Youngs Point when he died.

Widow, Mary F. NORRICK, resident of Richland Co OH, post office Mansfield, OH. [dated 25 Apr 1863] Mary was 38 yrs old.

Marriage: Mary J. NEWLON married David NORRICK on 20 Jan 1857.

Children:

Josiah W. NORRICK, born 18 June 1858, attended by Dr. Norman BAKER

Rachel O. NORRICK, born 24 May 1860, attended by Mary DEEMS. No physician was present.

Widow's death was reported in 1900.
