

He died and was buried at St. John's cemetery in Monroe township, Richland county, OH. His parents were John and Margaret [Pealer] Pealer who came to this country from Germany. George was born in Worthington Township, Richland county, OH. George's siblings: Jane, Eve, John Adam, John Christopher and Fredrick A. born in Germany; John Philip, John Martin, [George Alexander fits in here] Peter Alexander and Clark Alexander were born in Worthington township. George's brother John Martin of Company I, 64th OVI died after being shot in the right lung at Chickamauga.
