SHAMBAUGH, George* 12 Aug 1862

Private Shambaugh was 27 when he entered service. He died 7 March 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

1850 Monroe Township, Richland County OH: George SHAMBAUGH, age 58 PA, a farmer; Catherine, age 55 PA; Isaac [with name spelled SHOMBARGER] age 20 OH, a farmer; Eleanor, age 16 OH; George age 14 OH; Jane [female] age 13 OH.

World Connect also lists John as the oldest sibling for George. It also says that their mother's maiden name was Catherine WEIRICK. Also says George was born Dec 1835.

1860 Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Geo SHAMBAUGH, age 67 born PA, a farmer; Catherine, age 65 PA; Ellen, age 26 OH, a domestic; George, age 25 OH, a farmer; James, age 22 OH, a farmer; Mary Ann, age 26 [or maybe 20] OH; Eliza C, age 6 OH; Isaac, age 4 OH.
