1st Sergeant Simmons was 21 when he entered service.

Appointed Sergeant from private 1 Sept. 1863; 1st Sergeant on [date not given]; transferred to Co. E, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co E 48th OVI 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

John R. Simmons was born 19 Sept 1841 in Richland County, OH. He is the son of Amassa Simmons and Anne Ramsey. Amassa Simmons was a farmer living in Worthington Township. That is where John Ramsey Simmons was born. They were living there in Worthington Township at the time John R. joined the 120th.

John R. was a 21 year old school teacher when he enlisted as a private in the 120th Ohio Vol. Inf. Regt. He was one of the very lucky ones to make it through the war unscathed. He was transferred into the 114th Ohio, and he fought at Fort Blakely, Alabama. He was then transferred into the 48th Ohio, served in Galveston and was discharged in Houston on 14 Oct 1865. He was a First Sergeant at the time of discharge. [A bit of irony here: He fought against my mother's grand uncles at the battle of Arkansas Post in Jan, 1863. The two uncles were taken prisoner and transported to Springfield, IL where they both died of disease.]

I have no record of him ever going back to Ohio, but I assume he did go back to visit his relatives at some time. He migrated to Industry, Austin County, Texas where he became a school teacher there in Industry. He met a girl - Phillipine HARTING - who immigrated to Austin County in 1857 with her family from Prussia.

Date of marriage in Austin County, TX is 5 Jan 1868. He and Phillipine raised their children there in Industry.

John R. Simmons' date of death is 23 June 1922. He is buried in Industry, Austin County, Texas in the Methodist Church cemetery.
