STAUFFER, Matthias* 8 Aug 1862

Private Matthias Stauffer was 22 when he entered service. He was discharged 6 Mar 1863 at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri and died the same day before leaving the hospital.

In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery, St. Louis, Missouri but I don't see him listed at Interment site.

Father: Matthias STAUFFER

Mother: Elizabeth DRAPER [on tomb stone]]

Birth: <1840>

Marriage: Probably single

Death: 6 Mar 1863 at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri

Cemetery: Jefferson Barracks Cemetery, St. Louis, Missouri [Not listed in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery; may be buried there as an unknown]

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Mathias STAUFFER, Private, Co B 120th OH Inf, died 6 Mar 1863 at General Hospital Jefferson Barracks, MO. Cause: pneumonia.

Not found on Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960

Not on National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962

Not on Pension Index.

1850 Census Monroe Township, Richland County OH: [p 322] Matthias STOFER, age 52 PA, a farmer; Elizabeth, age 44 MD; Susanna, age 20 MD; Arin [male] age 17 MD, a farmer; Elizabeth, age 14 OH; John age 12 OH; Matthias, age 10 OH; William W, age 7 OH; Mary J, age 5 OH; Daniel, age 3 OH; David, age 2 OH; Jacob, age 44 PA.

1860 Census, Monroe Twp, Richland County, OH, page 296: Elizabeth STOFIFER, age 54 MD, manages a farm; John, age 22 OH, farmer; Mathias, age 19 OH. They are living with John B and Artemisia HACK and children. Mathias' siblings seem to be in the next household: Wm W. STOUFER, age 17 OH, Mary J, age 15 OH; Daniel, age 13 OH; David, age 12 OH.

Parents, Mathias died 1858 and Elizabeth STOUFFER died 1891 are buried at Saint John Cemetery, Perryville, Richland Co OH. Lists mother as Elizabeth DRAPER.
