STEWART, William W.* 12 Aug 1862

Private William Stewart was 21 when he entered service. He died 25 Jan 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

[father, Family Search, Ohio, Marriages, 1800-1958: Robert STEWART, married Mary FULTON 27 Jan 1853 at Richland Co OH.]
