

## Company B, 120<sup>th</sup> OVI

STONER, George W.\* 11 Aug 1862

Private Stoner was 33 when he entered service. He died 8 Apr 1863 at Milliken's Bend, Louisiana. In the Roll of Honor in the back of the Official Roster: buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Father: Jacob STONER

Mother: Anna Katherine FREYMYER [[Find a Grave](#)]

Birth: <1830> PA

Marriage: Margaret Ann STAKE on 24 May 1853, at McConnellsburg, Fulton Co PA

Death: 8 Apr 1863, Died on hospital boat, the "D A January" near Milliken's Bend, LA

Cemetery: Vicksburg, Mississippi [Not found on Vicksburg National Cemetery list. May be buried there as an unknown.]

Relationship: Brother of Merrick STONER, of Co H, 120th OVI.

Pension Index: George W STONER, B 120th OH Inf. Widow Margaret A STONER applied for widow's pension in 1863 June 18, Application 25102, no certificate, no state given. Minor, G [A] SMITH guardian, 1865 Mar 6, Application 85200, Certificate 123626, no state given.

Family:

1850 Census, McConnellsburg, Fulton Co PA, Dwelling 82, Family 83: Jacob STONER, age 55 PA, cabinet maker; Catherine, age 45 PA; William, age 21 PA, carpenter; Ann E., age 14 PA; Merrick A., age 11 PA; Albert, age 8 PA.

[Next door was John STONER, age 24 PA, cabinet maker and family.] [Brother Merrick served in the Civil War in Company H, 120th OVI.]

1850 Census, Chambersburg, Franklin Co PA, Dwelling 364, Family 394: George STONER, age 20 PA, cabinet maker is living with the Frederick and ??Ethelinda HENNINGER family. Frederick is also a cabinet maker.

1860 Census Worthington Township, Richland County OH: George STONER, age 30 PA, a master cabinet maker; Margaret, age 25 OH; Edward, age 5 PA; Merick [male] age 2 PA; Isabella, age 3 months OH; also living there is George WILSON age 21 PA, apprentice to cabinet maker[see George WILSON below].

Father, brother, and children of soldier:

1870 Census, McConnellsburgh Borough, Fulton Co PA, Dwelling 6, Family 8: Jacob STONER, age 76 PA, cabinet maker; Anna C BENFORD, age 28 PA; Albert STONER, age 26 PA, tinner; Edwin, age 13 PA; Merick, age 10 PA; Lolla, age 7 PA. [Jacob died 15 Jan 1876. buried McConnellsburg Lutheran Cem., [Find a Grave](#)]

Daughter, Laura:

1880 Census, McConnellsburg Borough, Fulton Co PA, Dwelling 39, Family 40: Anna BENFORD, age 42 PA, widow, parents born PA; Laura STONER, single, niece, age 17 OH, parents born PA.

1900 Census,

Merick, See Merrick STONER of [Company H](#):

1880 Census, Bedford west ward, Bedford Co PA, Dwelling 24, Family 24: Merick STONER, age 23 PA, no occupation listed, parents born PA ; Mary, wife, age 22 MD, parents born MD ; George, age one PA, son.

Son, Edward? Edward died 1929, buried at Sutton Cem, Clay Co Nebraska, [Find a Grave](#).

1880 Census, Russell Precinct, Otoe Co NE, Dwelling 149, Family 155: E A STONER, [male] age 25 PA, single, teacher, parents born PA. He is living with Geo. C. and Mary J UNDERHILL and family.

1900 Census, Aurora City, Hamilton Co NE, Dwelling 60. Family 62: Edward A. STONER, age 44 PA, born Apr 1856, married 14 yrs, tinner, parents born PA; Ida M, wife, age 35 IL, born Sept 1864, parents born OH; Edward A, son, age 16 IL, born Oct 1883; Albert, son, age 11 NE, born Aug 1888; Nannie, daughter, age 9

NE, born Jan 1891; Hazel, daughter, age 6, born Sep 1893; Charley, son, age 4 NE, born Mar 1896.  
1910 Census, Sutton Ward 2, Clay Co NE, Dwelling 164, Family 165: Edward A. STONER, age 55 PA, first marriage, married 27 yrs, parents born US, tinner in hardware store; Ida M, wife, age 45 IL, first marriage, married 27 yrs, 6 children/5 still living, parents born OH; Nettie, daughter, age 19 NE, single, no occupation; Hazel, daughter, age 16 NE, single; Charles, son, age 14 NE, single.  
1920 Census, Sutton Twp, Clay Co NE, James Ave, Dwelling 224, Family 230: Edward A. STONER, age 64 PA, parents born OH, tinsmith in hardware store; Ida May, wife, age 55 IL, parents born IL.

Did not find on 1890 Veterans Schedule.

Pension at fold3.com :

George STONER, Co B 120 OH Reg. Died on hospital boat, the "D A January", 8 Apr 1863, of chronic diarrhoea. Went onto steamer 5 Apr 1863 with acute dysentery. But Capt Rummel said that he died of typhoid fever or camp fever at Youngs Point LA on 1 Apr 1863 after becoming ill on about 5 Mar 1863.[but Rummel had a note that said he would not be positive as refers disease.] George had enrolled at Worthington Twp, OH.

Widow: George W. STONER married Margaret Ann STAKE on 24 May 1853, at McConnellsburg, Fulton Co PA by Rev Martin Bachtle or by McHENRY, Minister of the Gospel. [dated 28 May 1863]Margaret Ann STONER was 28 yrs old, resident of Newville, Richland Co OH. But Margaret H. STONER died 26 May 1864 [attended by Dr. J. P. HENDERSON], so a guardian was appointed for the children.  
Guardian, George A. SMITH, resident of Fulton Co PA, post office McConnellsburg PA. He was age 30[dated Feb 1865]. Dates had been written in Stoner's Bible which was in the possession of Jacob STONER, George's father who was living in McConnellsburg. The children, after their mother died, were sent to the care of their grandfather Jacob STONER in McConnellsburg.
