STRICKLER, John E. 2 Aug 1862

1st Lieutenant Strickler was age 34 when he entered service. He was appointed 1st Lieut. 4 Aug 1862; resigned 14 Jan 1863.

Father: David STRICKLER

Mother: Rebecca PIKE

Birth: 7 Sep 1825 [Find a Grave info]

Marriage: Elizabeth R. COULTER, 24 Apr 1856, Richland OH

Death: 16 July 1863, Lucas, OH at home

Cemetery: Perrysville Union Cem, Ashland Co OH.

[Ashland county military archives:](#) John E. STRICKLER Co B 120th OH, died at home, 16 June 1863.

Pension Index: John E STRICKLER, B 120th OH Inf. Widow, Elizabeth STRICKLER, filed 6 Oct 1863, Application 35213, Certificate 11307.

WorldConnect researcher lists John's parents as David STRICKLER and Rebecca PIKE. He was born in 1825 in York County PA.

1850 Census, Washington, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 164, Family 164: John STRICKLER, age 24 PA, farmer; Rebecca, age 43 PA; Harriet KISER, age 21 PA; William KISER, age 2 PA; Mary ??CASSE, age 41 PA.

Richland County Probate Court record: John E STRICKLER married Elizabeth R. COULTER on 24 Apr 1856 in Richland county OH.

1860 Census Lucas, Monroe Township, Richland County OH: John E STRICKLER, age 32 PA, a physician; Elizabeth R., age 25 OH, teaches in common school; Norman B. C., age 3 OH; Rebecca, age 50 PA; also living there is Elizabeth FAER or FACE, age 19, a domestic.

Not on 1890 Veterans Schedule.

[Pension papers: Resigned for reason of disability. Died 16 July 1863, chronic diarrhea. Child Norman B. STRICKLER born 11 Aug 1857. "Widow pensioned together with minor child. Remarried March 10, 1874, to Albert D. Zimmerman, Perrysville, Ashland County, Ohio. He died November 2, 1900, and after his death she made application to be restored to the pension rolls. Address at that time was 1436 East Main St., Columbus, Ohio. Died about 1905-06." John was studying medicine with Dr. W. [or N.] Baker in Lucas, Richland County for the 3 yrs previous to enlisting. Elizabeth got \$17. per month plus \$2 for the child.

Elizabeth remarried and her name was ZIMMERMAN, address 1436 E. Main St, Columbus, Franklin Co OH in June 1902. Albert ZIMMERMAN died 2 Nov 1900 in Columbus and was buried at Perrysville, Ashland Co OH. Elizabeth died 19 Oct 1904[sic].
