STULL, William 16 Aug 1862  
Private William Stull was 18 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co G, 21st Regiment, Veteran Reserve Corps on 15 Feb 1864; mustered out 15 Aug 1865 at Trenton, New Jersey.

Pension Card: William died 22 June 1908?????. Just plain wrong.

Pension Index: William STULL, Co B 120th OH Inf. dated 1907 in OH. [May have been for an increase in pension.]

They must be in PA in 1850 but I haven't found them yet.

????1860 Census Monroe Twp, Richland County OH, page 288: John STULL, age 38 PA, farmer; Rebecca, age 33 PA; Wm, age 15 PA; Mary C, age 12 PA; David, age 9 PA; Emily J, age 7 PA; Sarah, age 6 PA; Lelena B [female], age 3 OH.

????Richland County Probate Court record: William STULL married Sarah E TREAS on 26 Dec 1870 in Richland County, OH.

????1880 Census Elmwood, Tuscola County, MI, page 120: William STULL, age 35 PA, farmer, parents born PA; Saarah, wife, age 28 OH, parents born PA; Saarah R, daughter, age 5 MI. [Note: John STULL, age 58, and David STULL, age 29, are also living in Tuscola County MI in 1880.]

1890 Veterans Schedule: White River, Sioux Co NE

1900 Census, White River Pct, Sioux Co NE; Dwelling 147, Family 151: William STULL, age 53 PA, born May 1847, married 7 yrs, stock grower, parents born PA; Leah L., wife. age 56 Canada, born Oct 1843, married 7 yrs, 0 children, father born MD, mother born Canada.

1910 Census, White River Pct, Sioux Co NE, Dwelling 45, Family 45: William STULL, age 63 PA, second marriage, married 17 yrs, parents born PA, general farmer, column 30 marked UA for military service; Leah L., wife, age 66 Canada [French speaking], first marriage, married 17 yrs, 0 children, parents born Canada, came to US 1893.

1920 Census, Ozark Twp, Polk Co AR, Dwelling 146, Family 151: William STULL, age 74 PA, farmer, parents born PA; Leah L., age 76 Canada, father born MD, mother born Canada, came to US in 1849.

Apparently he was in Kansas first and then went to Los Angeles.

US National Homes for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers: Leavenworth, KS also in 1922. Mentions old injury to right foot. Has nearest relative as John E. Johnston of Newton KS. Admitted 15 Aug 1922 and discharged 15 Sep 1922 at his own request.

US National Homes for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers: Sawtelle, Los Angeles Co, CA

Admitted: 15 Aug 1922 [at Kansas]

Discharged: 15 Sep 1922

Readmitted: 27 Oct 1922[in California]

Enlisted Co B 120th OVI at Mansfield OH on 16 Aug 1862: Discharged 15 Aug 1865 at Trenton, NJ. Private.

Disabilities when admitted to Home: Defective Vision and hearing. Cardiac hypertrophy, Arteriosclerosis, etc.

Born PA. Age 76 at admittance. 5'7.5" Fair complexion, Brown eyes, Gray hair, can read and write, Protestant, Farmer, Residence subsequent to discharge, Newton, KS, Widowed. No name or address for nearest relative.
