VANSKOYOC, Peter 5 Aug 1862 VAN SCOYOC VANSKOYOC
Private Vanscoyce was 21 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co I, 17th Regiment, Veteran Reserve Corps [date not given]; mustered out 30 June 1865 at Indianapolis, Indiana.

Father: Peter VAN SCOYOC

Mother: Mary SWITZER

Birth: 5 Oct 1841 Richland OH

Marriage: Mary Ann KRUSE 15 Mar 1870, Noble, Indiana

Death: 3 Oct 1928 Oak Hill, Clay Co KS

Relationship: Brother-in-law of James M. First of Co. B, 120th OVI (Peter's sister, Sarah, married James).

Cemetery: Peter VAN SCOYOC, Pleasant Valley Cemetery, Oak Hill, Clay Co KS GAR marker

Pension Index: Peter VAN SCOYOC, B 120th OH Inf. and I 17th VRC. Invalid filed 1890 July 29, Application 957559, Certificate 981766, filed in Kansas. Widow, Mary VAN SCOYOC, filed 1928 Oct 18, Application 1626079, A-4-12-'29, filed in KS. Pension Card: Peter died 3 Oct 1928 at Oak Hill, KS.

[male], age 18 OH, laborer; Barbara, age 16 OH; Margaret, age 15 OH; Sarah, age 14 OH; Saml, age 10 OH; Peter, age 8 OH; Eliza, age 7 OH; Mary J, age 5 OH; Rebecca E, age 1 OH.

1860 Census Monroe Township, Richland County OH: Peter VAN SCOYOC, age 18 OH, a farm hand, is living with Peter and Mary SWITZER.

Researcher at Family Search: Peter VANSKOYOC married Mary Ann KRUSE on 15 Mar 1870 in Noble, Indiana.

1870 Census, Avilla, Allen Twp, Noble County, IN, page 104: Peter VANSKOYOC, age 28 OH, laborer; Mary, age 20 OH.

1880 Census, Oakland Twp, Clay County, KS, page 98: Peter VANSKOYAC, age 39 OH, farmer, parents born OH; Mary A, wife, age 29 OH, parents born Prussia; Sherman W, son, age 9 IN; Marvin P, son, age 7 KS; Frances M, daughter, age 5 KS; William M, son, age 4 KS; Sarah B, daughter, age 2 KS; Emana E, daughter, age 1 month KS, born May 1880.

Have not found on 1890 Veterans Schedule in KS.

1900 Census, Oakland Twp, Clay County, KS, page 147: Peter VAN SCOYOC, age 58 OH, born Oct 1841, married 30 yrs, farmer, parents born OH; Mary A, wife, age 49 OH, born Jan 1851, married 30 yrs, 13 children/9 still living, parents born Germany; Marvin P, son, age 26 KS, single, born Oct 1873, farm laborer; Mary F, daughter, age 24 KS, born Aug 1875, single; William M, age 23 KS, born Dec 1876, single, farm laborer; Sarah B, daughter, age 22 KS, born March 1878, single, music teacher; Alice E, daughter, age 17 KS, born Feb 1883, single; Frederick R, son, age 14 KS, born May 1886; James J, son, age 9 KS, born June 1890; Nola R, daughter, age 7 KS, born May 1893.

1910 Census, Oakland Twp, Clay County, KS, page 146: Peter VANSCOYOC, age 68 OH, first marriage, married 40 yrs, farmer on general farm, parents born USA; Mary A, wife, age 59 OH, first marriage, married 40 yrs, 13 children/9 still living, father born Germany, mother born USA; Nola, daughter, age 16 KS; Della GOHEEN, daughter, age 32 KS, first marriage, married 4 yrs, 2 children/2 still living; Lavone, granddaughter, age 2yrs and 10 months KS, father born KY, mother born KS; Letha A, granddaughter, age 1 yr and 2 months KS, father born KY, mother born KS; Frances VANSCOYOC, daughter, age 34 KS, single, dress maker at home. [Note: Column 30 marked UA for military service for Peter.] [Note: also listed on that same page were Fred R, 23 KS, and Marvin P, 36 KS who may have been sons of Peter and Mary.]

1920 Census, Oakland Twp, Clay County, KS, page 146: Peter VANSCOYOC, age 78 OH, general farmer, parents born OH; Mary A, wife, age 68 OH, father born Holland [spoke Dutch], mother born OH; Mary Francis, daughter, age 44 KS, single; Nola, daughter, age 25 KS, single, teacher in grade school; E E FIRST, nephew, age 57 OH, farm laborer, single, parents born OH.

At least 4 other children for Peter: Myrtilla, 1872; Emma 1880-81; Georgia 1885; Flossie, 1888-89. See [Findagrave](#).
