WILSON, George H. 5 Aug 1862
Private George Wilson was 24 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co E, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. [Promoted to Corporal] Corporal Wilson was transferred to Co E, 48th OVI 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

1860 Census, Hanover Twp, Ashland County, OH, page 64: Maxwell WILSON, age 48 PA, farmer; Sarah, age 45 PA; James, age 18 PA; Levina A, age 15 PA; Walter, age 13 OH; Sarah J, age 11 OH; Mary E, age 9 OH; Phebe, age 4 OH.

1860 Census Worthington Township, Richland County OH: George STONER, age 30 PA, a master cabinet maker[see George STONER above]; Margaret, age 25 OH; Edward, age 5 PA; Merick [male] age 2 PA; Isabella, age 3 months OH; also living there is George WILSON age 21 PA, apprentice to cabinet maker.

Richland County Probate Court Record: On 30 Aug 1866 George WILSON married Catherine McFARLAND in Richland County OH.

1880 Census Lucas, Monroe Township, Richland County OH: George H. WILSON, age 41 PA, works on RailRoad, parents born PA; Catherine, age 40 OH, father born VA, mother MD; Mark W, son, age 12 OH, works on farm; Emma M, daughter, age 11 OH; James V, son, age 9 OH; Martha J, daughter, age 7 OH; Anna E, daughter, age 5 OH; John O, son, age 2 OH; Dora A, daughter, age 2 OH; Lilly, daughter, age 4 months OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Monroe Twp, Richland Co OH: Line 10, House 30, Family 36: George H. WILSON, Corporal, Co E [incorrect], 120th OH Inf. Disabilities: diarrhoea and rheumatism.

1900 Lucas Village, Monroe Township, Richland County OH: George H WILSON, age 61 PA, born Aug 1838, married 33 yrs, a farmer, parents born PA; Catherine, wife, age 59 OH, born Mar 1841, married 33 yrs, 8 children, 8 still living, father born VA, mother born MD; John O, son, age 22 OH, born July 1877, single, a day laborer; Lily M, daughter, age 20 OH, single, born Jan 1880, a sales lady; Dora W. HOFFMAN, daughter, age 22 OH, a widow, born July 1877, a servant; Martha J. SMART, daughter, age 27 OH, born Nov 1872, married 0 years [this may mean under one year], no children, a servant.

1910 Lucas Village, Monroe Township, Richland County OH: George J WILSON, age 71 PA, 1st marriage, 43 yrs, no occupation, parents born PA; Catherine, wife, age 70 OH, father born MD, mother OH, married 43 yrs, 8 children, 8 still living.

1920 Precinct B, Mansfield City, Richland County, OH: James W. HARBAUGH, age 35 OH, a machinist on the Pennsylvania Railroad, parents born OH; Lillian M, wife, age 39 OH, parents born OH [that doesn't make sense]; George H WILSON, father-in-law, age 81 PA, a widower, parents born in PA.

Death record in Ohio: Geo H WILSON died 23 Feb 1922 in Mansfield, Richland County, OH. He was a widower. Occupation was carpenter. His parents were Maxwell WILLSON, born PA, and Sarah VOLKENBURG, born PA. He was born in Cannonsburg, PA, on 24 Aug 1838. He was buried at Mansfield Cemetery. The informant was John O WILSON of Mansfield.
