BUCKLEY, John E.* 12 Aug 1862

Private John Buckley was age 18 [Age probably incorrect] when he entered service. He was wounded 29 Dec 1862 in the battle of Chickasaw Bayou, Mississippi; died 28 Jan 1863 at St. Louis, Missouri.

The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at St. Louis, Missouri in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery. [Not listed at interment.net]

[The Ashland Union [Ashland Co OH] 4 March 1863]

"Died, In Hospital at St. Louis, Mo., January 28th 1863, of Typhoid fever, John E. Buckley, aged 28 years, 11 months and 17 days. The body of deceased was interred [sic] in Haysville, Ohio, on the 3d ult."

[Hayesville-Vermillion Cem, Ashland County](#): John E BUCKLEY died 1863 age 28 yrs Civil War and Mary BUCKLEY wife of John died 1872 age 34 yrs.

Sons of Union Veterans: Born 11 Feb 1834. Burial Vermillion Cem, SR60, Hayesville, Vermillion Twp, Ashland County, OH.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: John E. BUCKLEY, Private, Co C 120th OH Inf, died 28 Jan 1863 at General Hospital, Hospital of Refuge, St. Louis, MO. Cause: typhoid fever.

Pension Index: John E BUCKLEY, C 120th OH Inf. Widow, Mary A. BUCKLEY, filed 1863 Mar 25, Application 16081, Certificate 3665. [Note: This is definitely for the Soldier John BUCKLEY of Company C 120th OVI, so I have to think that the age in the roster may be wrong.]

1850 Census, Milton Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 172, Family 172: John BUCKLEY, age 42 PA, farmer; Elisabeth, age 42 PA; Maryann, age 18 PA; John, age 16 PA, farmer; Susanah, age 14 PA; Sarah A., age 11 PA; Aaron, age 7 PA; Dillan, age 1 PA.

Ashland County Marriages by Nellie M Raber: John E. BUCKLEY married Mary A BUDD 22 Dec 1859 in Ashland County OH.

1860 Census Green Twp, Ashland County OH page 292: John BUCKLEY, age 25 OH, a farm laborer; Mary A, age 21 OH. [Note: Living next door to William BUDD's family.]

1870 Census, Vermillion Twp, Ashland County, OH, page 847: Mary A BUCKLEY, age 32 OH, [living alone but near the BUDD family. Mary died in 1872.]

Widow's pension at fold3.com:

John E. BUCKLEY, Co C 120th OH. Widow Mary Ann BUDD.

John E. BUCKLEY died 28 Jan 1863 at St. Louis of typhoid fever.

The widow's declaration says John died at the hospital in Saint Louis, Missouri of typhoid fever and wounds received at the battle of Vicksburg on the 28th day of January 1863. Mary Ann married John E. BUCKLEY on the 22nd day of Dec. 1855. At the time she was a resident of Vermillion Twp, Ashland Co OH, post office Haysville. Her maiden name was Mary Ann BUDD.

According to the Adjutant's office, John was reported wounded and in hospital for Jan. and Feb 1863.

John E. BUCKLEY and Mary A BUDD were married 22 Dec 1859 at Ashland Co OH. Rev. R. LOCKHART.
