BUDD, Samuel* 12 Aug 1862 [[See another BUDD in Company A](#)]

Corporal Samuel Budd was age 25 when he entered service. He died 15 Mar 1863 at Paducah, Kentucky. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Mound City, [Pulaski Co], Illinois.[Not listed at Mound City National Cem at interment.com; not listed at Department of Veterans Affairs gravesite locator.] Stone at Vermillion Cemetery in Ohio.

Death: 15 Mar 1863 at Paducah, KY

Relationship: Samuel's sister, Mary A., may be the wife of John BUCKLEY, Co C 120th OVI; Brother of William BUDD of Co C, 120th OVI; Samuel's wife is the sister of James HARLAN of Co C 120th OVI.

Ashland County Vets: Samuel BUDD buried Hayesville Cemetery

Sons of Union Veterans: Born 1836. Burial Vermillion Cem, SR60, Hayesville, Vermillion Twp, Ashland County OH.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Samuel RUDD [incorrectly spelled and recorded], Corporal, Co C 120th OH Inf, died 15 Mar 1863 at General Hospital Paducah KY. Cause: peritonitis.

Not on US Department of Veterans Affairs as Samuel BUDD or Samuel RUDD.

Pension Index: Samuel BUDD, C 120th OH Inf. Widow, Mahala BUDD, filed 1863 May 25, Application 22411, Certificate 36450. No state given.

Listed in the Wooster Republican on 29 January 1863:

In St. Marks Hospital, Paducah Kentucky, L.S. Holton Surgeon in charge: S. Bude wounded slightly.

This could be Samuel in the 1850 Census Green Township, Ashland County OH pages 111 and 112: Thomas BUDD, age 38 PA, a farmer; William BUDD, age 15 OH, a farmer; S BUDD male, age 13 OH; M A BUDD [female], age 12 OH; ?C Budd female, age 9 OH; A BUDD female, age 7 OH; I BUDD male, age 5 OH; D BUDD male, age 3 OH; E BUDD female age 60 NJ; E BUDD female, age 25 PA. [Note: see brother William below.] [Note: Parents.....Family Search has a marriage for Thomas BUDD and Rebecca BLACK on 26 Jun 1834 in Richland County OH.]

1860 Census Vermillion Township, Ashland County OH: Samuel BUDD, age 24 OH, a farmer; Mahala, age 20 OH; Thomas, age 1 OH.

1870 Census Vermillion Township, Ashland County OH; Mahala BUDD, age 27 OH, keeping house; Thomas age 11 OH; Margaret E, age 9 OH; Samuel, age 7 OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Vermillion Twp, Ashland Co OH; Line 27, House 268, Family 269: Mahala widow of Samuel BUDD, Pvt, Co C 120th OH Inf. Post office Hayesville, OH. Died at Paducah KY, 15 Mar 1863.

1900 Census Vermillion Twp, Ashland County OH, page 221: Mahala BUDD, head of household, age 59 OH, born July 1840, a farmer, 3 children/ 2 still living, a widow, father born OH, mother born NJ.

Wife: Ohio, Deaths, 1908-1953: Mahala BUDD died 14 Jan 1926 at Ashland, Ashland Co OH. Residence: 310 College Ave. Widow of Samuel BUDD. Born 18 July 1840 at Ashland Co OH. Father Samuel HARLIN, born MD. Mother Margaret HOFFER[hard to read, but it says HOFFER on the death certificate of Mahala's brother Daniel], born Germany. Informant Samuel E. BUDD of 310 College Ave, Ashland OH. Burial Hayesville Cem.

Death record in Ohio: Brother David BUDD's death certificate says his parents were Thomas BUDD, born PA and Rebeca BLACK, born OH. David died 11 May 1922 in Ashland County.

Death record in Ohio: Daughter, Margaret Jane BARTLEY's death certificate verifies that her parents were Samuel BUDD and Mahaley HARLAN, both born in Ashland County, OH. Mahala BUDD's death record verifies that her father's name was HARLIN. She died 14 Jan 1926 in Ashland.

Major McKinley certified that Samuel had been wounded a short time before he died. A druggist, William B. FASIG, at the hospital in Paducah testifies from personal knowledge that Samuel was suffering from wounds received in battle when he came to the hospital, but he recovered from the wound only to be attacked with disease and died. The hospital records were destroyed in a fire 25 Mar 1864.

One document asked for back payment for minor children Thomas J, , Margaret Jane and Samuel E. It was witnessed by John C DAVIS and Daniel P. HARLAN.

Thomas J, born 31 May 1859, at Green Twp, Ashland Co OH, attended by Dr. Samuel Glass

Margaret Jane born 7 Apr 1861, Dr. James Slocum attended.

Samuel E, born 9 Mar 1863, attended by Dr. Samuel Glass

Payment to Mahala stopped when Mahala died. 14 Jan 1926 at Ashland Co OH.

L. S. Horton, A. Assistant Surgeon, USA: Samuel Budd was admitted to USA ("St. Marks") General Hospital No. 3 in Paducah KY from a hospital steamer which came from the vicinity of Vicksburg, on 13 Jan 1863 with a contusion of the right ankle. He recovered from the injury but was attacked with inflammation of the peritoneum while in hospital. He had no disease when admitted and died of that complaint at 2:20 a.M. Sunday, March 15, 1863. This report "came from a copy of the prescription book used in that Hospital, and a copy of the 'Monthly Report of Sick and Wounded,' retained by me."

Captain McKinley said that Samuel received his wounds on 29 Dec 1862 near Vicksburg while in the line of duty as a soldier.

Samuel was age 26 when he joined the regiment, 5'10", light complexion, blue eyes, sandy hair and was a carpenter by trade.

Mahala's birth date was 18 July 1840. She married Samuel BUDD on 4 Sep 1858.

Letter in pension file:

"State of Ohio Ashland Co

Personally appeared before me William B Fasig whom I certify to be entitled to credit and who being duly sworn says that he was engaged as druggist in the Hospital at Paducah Kentucky when Samuel Budd was received at said Hospital at which time he was suffering from wounds received in battle. Affiant says that the said Samuel Budd recovered from his wounds but was afterwards while in hospital was taken with disease the nature of which affiant does not now recollect of which he died in said Hospital March 15th 1863...."
