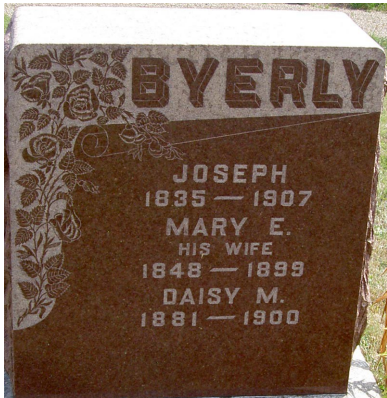

BYERLY, Joseph 12 Aug 1862

Private Byerly was age 27 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. H 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

Father: Andrew BYERLY

Mother: Elizabeth SKILES

Birth: 1835 ?OH

Marriage: Mary Ellen SHAFFER, 2 Jan 1868 at Ashland Co OH.

Death: 22 Dec 1907, Vermillion, Ashland Co OH

Cemetery: Bethesda Cemetery, Green Twp, Ashland Co, OH.

In the Wooster Republican, 29 Jan, 1863: Listed as being in Overton Hospital, Memphis Tennessee: Joseph Byerly of Company C, 120th. Also

listed is a James Byerly of this same company, but "James" is not on this roster or any roster for the 120th.

World Connect researcher: Joseph's parents were Andrew BYERLY and Elizabeth nee SKILES [BLACK]. Andrew died in 1845 in Ashland Co and Elizabeth died in 1866 in Ashland Co OH.]

Pension Index: Joseph BYERLY, F 48th Battalion, C 120th and H 114th OH Inf. Invalid filed 27 June 1889, Application 713108, Certificate 734135, in Ohio. Pension Card: Joseph died 22 Dec 1907.

1850 Census, Vermillion Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 370, Family 378: Andrew BIRELY, age 65 PA, blacksmith; Elizabeth, age 64 PA; Peter, age 23 OH, blacksmith; Eliza, age 19 OH; Joseph, age 15 OH, laborer.

1860 Census, Vermillion Township, Ashland County OH, page 152: Joseph BYERLY, age 23 PA, laborer; Elizabeth, age 74? PA. [Note: according to researcher at World Connect, Elizabeth would be his mother.]

Family Search, Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1997: Joseph BYERLY married Mary Ellen SHAFFER, 2 Jan 1868 at Ashland Co OH.

1870 Census Brown Twp, Knox County, OH, page 209: Joseph BYERLY, age 35 OH, a farmer; Mary E, age 22 OH; Grant, age 10 months OH, born in July 1869. They are living with the family of Elizabeth PEASTER? [47 Germany] and Barbary, Margaret, George and Mary PEASTER?.

1880 Census Vermillion Twp, Ashland Co, OH, page 253: Joseph BYERLY, age 42 OH, a farmer; Mary, age 36 OH; Grant, age 11 OH; Irene, age 9 OH; Cora, age 7 OH; Peter age 5 OH. [Note: wife Mary E. died 1899]

1890 Veterans Schedule: Vermillion, Ashland Co OH, Line 23, House 241, Family 253: Joseph BYERLY, Pvt, Co C 120 OH Inf. Post Office: Hayesville, OH.

1900 Census, Vermillion Township, Ashland County OH, page 221: Joseph BYERLY, age 64 OH, born June 1835, a widower, a farmer, parents born PA; Grant, son, age 30 OH, born July 1869, single, a sawyer; Cora O, daughter, age 25 OH, born Apr 1875, single; Peter O, son, age 21 OH, born Aug 1878, single, farm laborer; Maud L, daughter, age 14 OH, born May 1886, single, at school. [Note: There was another daughter, Daisy M, born 1881, died 1900.]

Daughter's Death record in Ohio: File #112, Cora Olive BYERLY died 15 Jan 1930 at Vermillion Twp, Ashland Co OH. Single. Born 8 Apr 1875 in OH. Bather Joseph BYERLY born OH. Mother Mary Ellen SHAFER, born OH. Informant Peter BYERLY RFD 3, Loudonville, OH. Burial Bathesda Chapel, Ashland Co OH.

Son's Death record in Ohio: File # 59290, R. Grant BYERLY died 29 Sep 1936 at Mansfield Gen. Hospital, Mansfield, Richland Co OH. Residence 53 Dawson St. Carpenter. Born 20 Jul 1869 in OH. Father Joseph BYERLY born OH. Mother Mary E SHAFER born OH. Burial Memorial ???.

Daughter's Death record in Ohio: File #5470, Mary BAKER died 29 June 1939 at Cleveland City Hospital, Cuyahoga Co, Cleveland OH. [Residence 1697 East 81 st], Widow of Jefferson. Born 6 Sep 1877 in Knox Co OH. Father Joseph BYERLY born PA. Mother Mary Ellen SHAFFER. Informant Alma BAKER of 1697 East 81 St. Burial Brimstone Corners, OH. [Note: This is Mary Irene Byerly BAKER buried at Bethesda Cem, Ashland Co OH.]
