CAKE, Thomas C. 13 Aug 1862

Private Cake was age 22 when he entered service. He was transferred to Veteran Reserve Corps on 15 Jan 1864.

Widow, Bertha C CAKE, filed 1906 May 31, Application 849778, no Certificate, filed in OH. Minor, John MAGLOTT guardian, filed 1907 March 30, Application 866478, Certificate 631041, filed in OH. [There is a John MAGLOTT living in Mansfield, Richland Co OH in 1910. He is a physician.] Pension Card: Thomas died 6 May 1906 at Toledo, OH.

1850 Census Vermillion Township, Ashland County OH, page 407: George H CAKE, age 51 MD, a farmer; Eliza, age 45 PA; Milton, age 18 OH; Thomas C, age 10 OH; Sarah A WELCH, age 7 OH. [Stark Co OH Probate Court Records: George H CAKE married Eliza WEBB 20 Oct 1822. Death record in Ohio: Milton's death certificate confirms that his mother was Eliza WEBB.]

1860 Census, Hayesville, Ashland County OH, page 156: John STEVENS, age 28 PA, wagon maker; Elizabeth, age 25 PA; Wm, age 3 OH; Benj. J, age 2 months OH; Thos. COKE, age 20 OH, wagon maker apprentice.

1880 Census Loudonville, Ashland County page 65: Thomas CAKE, age 40 OH, wagon maker, father born MD, mother born PA; Susan, wife, age 36 OH, parents born PA; Nola, daughter, age 18 OH; Ollie, daughter, age 10 OH.

Sons of Union Veterans: Thomas CAKE, Co F of the 17th VRC. Born 1840. Died 1893. [This date is not correct! That is the date that his wife, Susannah, died. CAKE Jr., age 59 OH, born June 1840, married 5 yrs, carriage maker, parents born Germany; Bertha, wife, age 26 OH, born Dec 1873, married 5 yrs, 2 children/2 still living, father born OH, mother born PA; Thomas C., Jr., ag 4 OH, born Jan 1896, parents born OH; Harlo, son, age 2 OH, born Nov 1897, parents born OH.

1910 Census, Cottage 18, [Ohio Soldiers and Sailors Orphans Home, Xenia Twp, Greene County, OH](#), page 100: Thomas C CAKE, pupil, age 14 OH; Harlo E CAKE, pupil, age 13 OH. [There is also a Sarah CAKE living there, age 8]
