

## Company C, 120<sup>th</sup> OVI



CHRISTINE, Samuel\* 21 Aug 1862

Private Christine was age 31 when he entered service. He died 2 May 1863 at Milliken's Bend, Louisiana.

The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi in section E, grave 65.

Pension Card: Samuel CHRISTINE, Co C 120th OH Inf. Widow, Mary CHRISTINE, applied 17 Sep 1863, Application 33486, Certificate 28945. Minor guardian Joseph STONE applied 25 Sep 1876, Application 228085, Certificate 175837.

1850 Census, Wooster, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 202, Family 203: Samuel CHRISTINE, age 45 PA, carpenter; Margaret, age 44 PA; Samuel, age 19 PA, sculpt\*\*\*; Agnes, age 14 OH; Amanda, age 9 OH; Benjamine, age 8 OH; William, age 4 OH.

Wayne County Probate Court record: Samuel CHRISTINE married Mary SLANE 11 Oct 1855 in Wayne County OH. [But this is actually Mary S. STRINE. See death information below.]

1860 Census Loudonville, Ashland County, OH, page 176: Samuel CHRISTINE, age 28 PA, marble manufacturer; Mary, age 24 OH; Ida E, age 3 OH; Avra? M [female] age 1 OH.

1870 Census Union Township, Logan County OH, page 279: Mary CHRISTINE, age 30 OH; Orra, age 11 OH; John age 9 OH; Allice, age 6 OH.

Wayne County Probate records: Mary S. CHRISTINE married Joseph HUNTER 25 May 1876 in Wayne County OH.

1900 Census, 329 Lawrence St, Portland Twp, Sandusky City, Erie Co OH, Dwelling 337, Family 372: Joseph HUNTER, age 91 PA, born Nov 1808, married 35 yrs, parents born PA ; Mary, wife, age 64 OH, born Oct 1835, married 35 yrs, 4 children/3 still living, parents born VA.

Joseph HUNTER died 11 Apr 1905 at DeGraff, Logan Co, OH

1910 Census, 67 Mill St, Miami Twp, Logan Co, OH, Dwelling 67 : Mary S. HUNTER, age 73 OH, widow, 4 children/3 still living, father born MD, mother born PA; Anna SHRISTINE, grand daughter, age 15 VT, father born OH, mother born VT; Irving SHRISTINE, grand son, age 12 MA, father born OH, mother born VT.

Mary S. HUNTER, C W Widow, 28945 died 14 Dec 1917, Bellfontaine, Logan Co OH. 125 E. Sandusky Ave.

Daughter's Death record in Ohio: Daughter [Ida], Mrs. J. Y. KAUFFMAN died 7 Jan 1918 in Bellefontaine, Logan County, OH. Born 6 Sep 1856 in OH. Parents were Samuel CHRISTINE and Mary STRINE, both born OH.

Sister's Death record in Ohio: File #28772, Mrs. Amanda Cordelia LEIES died 19 Apr 1918 at Wooster, Wayne Co OH. Married. Born 8 Oct 1840 in Wooster, OH. Father Samuel CHRISTINE born PA. Mother Margaret MILLER born PA. Informant Harry LEIES of Wooster, OH. Burial Wooster Cem.

Widow's pension at fold3.com :

Mary CHRISTINE, widow of Samuel CHRISTINE, Pvt, Co D 120th OH Vols. He post office was Loudonville, OH.

Samuel died in hospital at Milliken's Bend, LA, 2 May 1863. "Surgeon General reports that soldier died 2 May 1863 on board hospital steamer "D. S. January", of chronic diarrhoea. Soldier died near Vicksburg, MS. Mary STRINE and Samuel CHRISTINE married 11 Oct 1855 at Wayne Co OH.

"Head Quarters 120th regt Ohio Vols

Morganza La July 20th 1864

I hereby certify that Samuel Christine a private in Company C. of the 120th Regiment Ohio Volunteer Infantry died at Millikens Bend La on the 2nd day of May A.D. 1863 of chronic diarrhoe [sic] contracted while in the service of the United States in the line of his duty; and further that the books, papers and records of the said Company & regiment were all lost on the steamer City Bell captured by the Rebels on Red River on the 3rd day of May 1864 heretofore full descriptive rolls can not be furnished.

& late Captain Co C 120th OVI"

14 Feb 1867 Mary Christine was resident of Hicksville, Defiance Co OH. Pension certificate was 28945. Info about children of Mary and Samuel: **Ida** CHRISTINE who was born 6 Sep 1856 in Morland, Wayne Co OH [doctor in attendance was Samuel Wilson]. **Orah** CHRISTINE was born 20 Sep 1858 at Loudenville, Ashland Co OH [doctor in attendance was Ephram B. Fuller]. **John Jr** CHRISTINE was born 3 Dec 1860 at Loudonville, Ashland Co OH [doctor in attendance was Ephram B. Fuller]. **Anna M.** CHRISTINE was born 25 Jan 1863 at Loudonville, Ashland Co OH [doctor in attendance was Ephram B. Fuller].

On 4 Mar 1874 Mary lost her Certificate in the Post Office in Springfield OH [Clark Co]. She applied for another certificate. A sum of money was also missing with the certificate.

In Wayne Co OH, Joseph STRINE was appointed guardian for John W and Annie M. CHRISTINE on 16 Sep 1876. He was resident of Fredricksburg, Wayne Co OH, age 25. Mary CHRISTINE had married Joseph HUNTER of Applecreek, Wayne Co OH on 25 May 1876 in Wayne Co OH. Henry GOUDY and Annie M STRINE were witnesses.

Another paper with info about the children on 25 June 1867, had Mary CHRISTINE's post office address as Degraff, Logan co OH.

22 May 1905 Mary HUNTER applied for an increase in pension....residence DeGraff, Logan Co OH. Joseph HUNTER had died 11 Apr 1905 at DeGraff OH. [Joseph HUNTER had not served in the military.] Adene and A. L. GOLLADAY were witnesses for Mary on 19 May 1905. Anthony and Amanda LEICE of Wayne co OH were witnesses for Mary.

Letter from daughter to pension bureau, 30 Oct 1916 from 125 E. Sandusky Ave, Bellefontaine, OH: Mary was born 1 Nov 1835 on farm in Wayne Co OH near Wooster. Mary was almost blind at that time and was living with Ida. The letter was from Ida E. Christine KAUFFMAN.
