CRAIG, Gibson 22 Aug 1862          David Gibson CRAIG          D. G. CREIG  
Private Craig was age 22 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

1860 Census, Vermillion Twp, Ashland Co OH, page 134: Wm CRAIG, age 43 PA, farmer; Margaret, age 39 OH; Agnes, age 21 PA; David G, age 19 PA, farm laborer; Wm P, age 18 PA, farm laborer; Samuel, age 14 PA; Jonathan F, age 6 OH; Franklin E, age 5 OH; Walter L, age 3 OH; Charles E, age 10 months OH.

family, 1870 Census, Lukin Twp, Lawrence Co IL, Dwelling 63, Family 63: William CRAIG, age 55 PA, farmer; Margaret, age 49 OH; Samuel, age 24 OH, works on farm; Girtrude, age 16 OH; Franklin, age 15 OH; Walter, age 13 OH; James, age 9 OH; Mary PROVINE[s]?, age 14 OH.

Note: In 1880 the family is in Lukin, Lawrence Co IL. [Dwelling 249, Family 260] William, Margaret, Charles E., James P [age 18] are in one dwelling. Walter[Dwelling 249, Family 261] and Jonathan[Dwelling 248, Family 258] are on the same page with their families. I don't find David/Gibson CRAIG in IL.

Brother, Family Search: Illinois Deaths and Stillbirths, 1916-1947: [Frank CRAIG](#) died 2 Nov 1938 at Olney, Richland Co IL, age 83. Born 18 Aug 1855 at Ashland OH. Father William D. CRAIG born Washington Co PA. Mother Margaret FINLEY, birthplace unknown. Occupation carpenter-RR bridge. Residence Olney, Olney Twp, Richland Co IL. Wife: Harriet E. CRAIG.

This does not seem to be the David CRAIG of the 120<sup>th</sup>:

Family Search, Ohio, Deaths and burials, 1854-1997: David CRAIG died 30 Jun 1896 at Erie, OH. Age 56, born <1840>. Marital status unknown. Soldiers and Sailors Home. But...there is a gravestone order for David CRAIG Co H 25th OH Inf. Cemetery: State Soldiers' Home, Erie Co OH, grave 222, died 30 June 1896. So this is probably NOT David Craig of the 120th. There is a pension index card for David CRAIG of Co H, 25th OH Inf. No mention on it of any other regiment.
