DAVIS, Stephen* 22 Aug 1862

Private Davis was age 20 when he entered service. He was killed 11 Jan 1863 in the battle of Arkansas Post, Arkansas. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Arkansas Post, Arkansas.

1850 Census, Vermillion Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 403, Family 411: Reuben H. DAVIS, age 39 PA, millwright; Elizabeth, age 36 OH; Margaret E., age 14 OH; Elizabeth Ann, age 10 OH; Stephen, age 8 OH; Catharine M., age 6 OH; Martha A., age 4 OH; John B, age 2 OH

[Note: Wayne County Probate Court record: Reuben DAVIS married Elizabeth BAY on 18 Dec 1834 in Wayne Co OH.]

[Note: The reason I am including this information is that one researcher thinks that Cora Beck SWEARENGIN was the daughter of this soldier Stephen. But I believe she was his niece. Stephen's sister Elizabeth Ann DAVIS married Daniel SWEARENGIN on 9 Jan 1861 in Wayne Co OH.....Wayne County Probate Court record. And Cora's [Cora BECK wife of George] [Death record in Ohio](#) lists her father as Danial SWEARINGEN. And Elizabeth Ann's [Death record in Ohio](#) is messed up. Her father was Reuben DAVIS not Reuben SWEARINGEN. That could be the cause of some of the confusion.]

1860 Census, Hayesville, Ashland County OH, Dwelling 1059, Family 1096: Stephen DAVIS, age 19 OH, shoemaker apprentice is living with the Henry BRANT, shoemaker, and Nancy BRANT family. Also apprenticing there is Wm BUZZARD of this company.

Mother?, siblings, 1860 Census, Perry, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 682, Family 682: James SCOTT, age 61 PA, farmer and carpenter; Elizabeth, age 44 OH; Alfred, age 22 OH, farm laborer; Jackson, age 19 OH, farm laborer; Lydia, age 14 OH; Martha A. DAVIS, age 13 OH; John B. DAVIS, age 11 OH. [Elizabeth DAVIS married James SCOTT on 24 Aug 1858 at Ashland Co OH.]
